



ASSOCIATE IN ARTS FOR INTERDISCIPLINARY EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (IECE)

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a bachelor's degree in IECE.

IECE is a selective admission and competitive program. Completing this pathway does NOT guarantee you acceptance into the program. Acceptance is determined through the application process. A 2.75 cumulative GPA will be needed for this program.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with the UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure both KCTCS and UK requirements are met.
