

**KCTCS – UK Pathway to Transfer Guide
Associate in Science for Biology – B.A.**

Suggested Course Sequence

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy both the requirements for an Associate in Science degree at KCTCS institutions as well as the UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and the pre-major requirements for the Bachelor of Arts degree in Biology.

Biology is a major in the College of Arts and Sciences, and therefore the requirements for the College of Arts and Sciences must be fulfilled to complete the bachelor's degree. One of the A&S requirements is that students complete the fourth college semester of a single foreign language, or if the student had 2 years of a foreign language in high school, they could complete the third college semester of a second foreign language. The suggested curriculum would partially satisfy the College of Arts & Sciences foreign language requirement.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with their academic and transfer advisors each semester to ensure they are addressing both KCTCS and UK requirements.
