



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2022-2023

Associate in Art to Bachelor of Science in
Merchandising, Apparel, and Textiles

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and leads to a Bachelor of Science in Merchandising, Apparel, and Textiles at the University of Kentucky.

Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the College of Agriculture Food and Environment (CAFE).

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

The College of Agriculture, Food, and Environment requires that students complete a 320-hour, 8-week internship in a selected agency or organization, under the joint supervision of a qualified manager and a university internship supervisor. All MAT & RTM courses must be completed with a "C" or better.

General Transfer Requirements
