TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2022-2023

Associate in Science to Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a bachelor's degree in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education.

Admission Requirements

Interdisciplinary Early Childhood Education is a selective admission and competitive program. Completing this pathway does NOT guarantee you acceptance into the program. Acceptance is determined through the application process. A 2.75 cumulative GPA, passing scores on basic-skills tests, and experience with the appropriate student population will be needed for this program.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

Students may transfer a total of 67 credit hours from a two-year institution. Additionally, 30 of the final 36 credit hours earned toward a UK degree must be completed at UK. To graduate, students must get admitted to the Teacher Education Program (TEP), maintain a 2.75 cumulative UK GPA, and complete 120 total credit hours.

General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

It's strongly recommended that IECE students take *either* EDU 130 (through KCTCS) *or* EDS 375 (through UK) prior to starting at UK full-time. EDS 375 is the prerequisite course for all upper-level EDS courses required in this major. Note that the EDU 130 substitution applies only to IECE majors, and may not be transferrable to other UK majors requiring EDS 375.

If EDU 130 is taken through KCTCS, then one additional elective hour will be needed to reach the 120 hours required for this degree.
