



## TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate in Science to Bachelor of Science in  
Agricultural Economics (Agribusiness Management &  
Food Marketing Option)

### Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at the Kentucky Community and Technical College System and pre-major requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Economics (Agribusiness Management & Food Marketing Option).

### Admission Requirements

Students must meet the University admission requirements to be admitted into any major within the Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### Degree Requirements

The Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment requires that students in the Agricultural Economics major must earn a "C" or higher in MAT 170 (MA 123) and ECO 201. There are three options to earn a bachelor's degree (BS) in Agricultural Economics: (1) Advanced Studies in Agricultural Economics, (2) Agricultural Economics, and (3) Agribusiness Management & Food Marketing. The latter option requires students to complete a minor in business (MKT 300, MGT 301, FIN 300, & AN 300). To satisfy the Academic Enrichment Requirement, students may complete either: (1) an internship, (2) an independent research project, or (3) study abroad. This plan shows the student completing an internship (AEC 399) in the summer. Students must earn a "C" or higher in ECO 201, MAT 170, AEC 302, 303, 305, 306 and 422 or 490.

### General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at <https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising>.
