



TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2023-2024

Associate in Arts to Bachelor's in Arts in Sport
Leadership

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Arts at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and as many pre-major requirements as possible for a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sport Leadership.

Admission Requirements

The Bachelor of Arts Degree in Sport Leadership requires students to maintain a 2.0 GPA for retention in and exit from the program with a bachelor's degree.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

Degree Requirements

Students may transfer a total of 67 credit hours from a two-year institution. Additionally, 30 of the final 36 credit hours earned toward a UK degree must be completed at UK. Students in the program will be able to choose from three tracks: Sport Leadership Careers, Sport Leadership Entrepreneurs, and Sport Leadership Gaming. Students should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor to plan coursework specific to these tracks or specific minors and certificates of interest.

General Transfer Requirements

All prospective transfer students are encouraged to receive advising from the University of Kentucky Transfer Center. Appointments are offered online and in-person, and can be scheduled online at <https://www.uky.edu/admission/transfer-advising>.
