Associate in Science to Bachelor of Health Sciences
in Human Health Science

Overview

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky and pre-major requirements for a Bachelor of Health Sciences degree in Human Health Sciences.

Admission Requirements

The College of Health Sciences Human Health Science major is a highly selective program at UK with additional requirements, including a 3.0 cumulative GPA which must be maintained, minimum 'C' grade in all courses required for graduation. A grade of D or E in any course or a semester with a GPA that falls below 3.0 will result in HHS probation or suspension. Additional admissions information is available here:
