Associate in Science to Bachelor's in Integrated  
Strategic Communication (ISC)

### **Overview**

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for an Associate in Science at KCTCS as well as UK Core requirements for the University of Kentucky for a bachelor's degree in Integrated Strategic Communication (ISC).

### **Admission Requirements**

The College of Communication and Information is a selective admission college and requires a 2.0 cumulative GPA. If the student elects to pursue a Bachelor's in Science in ISC or chooses Option B under the Bachelor of Arts, the foreign language courses will differ. Please consult a UK advisor in such an instance.

KCTCS students planning to transfer to the University of Kentucky should work closely with a UK Transfer Advisor each semester to ensure that both KCTCS and UK degree requirements are met.

### **Degree Requirements**

If the student elects to pursue a Bachelor of Science in ICT or chooses Option B under the Bachelor of Arts, the Foreign Language requirements will differ. Please consult a UK Advisor in such an instance.
