



Paso Fino

Type: Light Breed

Origin: Puerto Rico

Uses: Showing, pleasure riding

Important Traits: Unique, short-strided, four-beat gait, gentle in hand but show great spirit under saddle, perform gaits such as the Classic Fino, Paso Corto and Paso Largo.

Size: 14 to 15 Hands

Description: The Paso Fino is a small- to medium-sized horse. They have a slightly convex profile and a small head with eyes that are wide spaced and flared and wide nostrils. The legs appear delicate and small hooves.

Color Pattern: Horses can be any solid or spotted color. Appaloosa patterns are excluded.
