Type: Light Breed, Pleasure type

Origin: Tennessee

Uses: Showing, trail and pleasure riding

Important Traits: Intelligence, naturally smooth gaited, nodding their head at the running walk

Size: 14.3 to 17 Hands

Description: Many Tennessee Walking Horses that are used for performance are shown with double or triple nailed pads which add dimension to the hoof, change certain angles and paths in the hoof's motion, and provide a sounder base. These pads accent the gaits of show horses. If the horse is used for pleasure riding, they will not have special shoes.
