Trakehner

Type: Light Breed, Warmblood

Origin: East Prussia

Uses: Dressage, jumping and eventing

Important Traits: Strong joints and muscle, ground-covering gaits

Size: 16 to 17 Hands and above

Description: The Trakehner is a tall horse although the legs are shorter than those of most Thoroughbreds. The head reflects its Arabian heritage. The eyes are large and the forehead is wide. The Trakehner has a deep chest and muscular, sloped shoulders.

<u>Color Pattern:</u> Can be any solid color with the most popular being chestnut. May also be bay, brown, black, and gray. Minimal white markings on face and lower legs are common.
