## PLEADING CYCLE ESTABLISHED FOR OPPOSITIONS AND REPLIES TO OPPOSITIONS TO PETITION FOR PARTIAL RECONSIDERATION OF THE *VIDEO DESCRIPTION EXPANSION ORDER*

On September 21, 2017, the Federal Communications Commission released a *Public Notice*<sup>1</sup> listing a petition for partial reconsideration of the Commission's *Video Description Expansion Order*.<sup>2</sup> The *Public Notice* was subsequently published in the Federal Register.<sup>3</sup>

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, the opposition and reply deadlines for the petition are 15 days and 25 days, respectively, after publication of the *Public Notice* in the Federal Register.<sup>4</sup> The *Public Notice* was published in the Federal Register on October 3, 2017. Accordingly, oppositions will be due **October 18, 2017**, and replies to oppositions will be due **October 30, 2017**.
