The Lewiston Transit system provides rides in the city of Lewiston, Idaho. Through a system of interconnecting service providers (Asotin County PTBA & Appaloosa Express) Lewiston Transit provides safe, reliable transportation to everyone in the Lewis-Clark Valley. Everyone 18 or younger always rides free.

The fixed route services for Lewiston Transit and their connecting lines are a dollar or less. They offer Half Fare Cards to seniors age 62 and older, qualified disabled individuals and Medicare card holders. The fixed route vehicles are also equipped with ADA accessible features (wheelchair/standee lift, stop request pull cords etc.) The fixed route lines also provide bike racks for your convenience. Other services they provide: For disabled riders who are unable to use the regular fixed-route buses, ADA Paratransit services are a lift equipped, curb-to-curb service operating in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) is available. Travel is provided within Lewis-Clark Valley. These services are provided during the same days and times that the fixed route services are running.
