




INTERSTATE 10, SCADDAN WASH TO PLOMOSA PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROJECT FACT SHEET

OVERVIEW

The Arizona Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) are repairing the pavement on Interstate 10 between Scaddan Wash (milepost 24) and Plomosa (milepost 30), east of the town of Quartzsite. The work consists of removing the existing pavement surface and replacing it with new asphalt concrete and minor bridge rehabilitation.



PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction is scheduled to begin in spring 2024 with completion anticipated in winter 2024.

WHAT TO EXPECT

To minimize traffic impacts, paving is scheduled to occur from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. on weekdays. Other related work will take place during the day.

Drivers are asked to obey posted speed limits and traffic control devices and use caution around construction personnel and equipment.

ADOT will provide advance notice of restrictions and closures to email subscribers and on the project traffic alert web page.

PROJECT ELEMENTS

- Milling the existing pavement and replacing it with new pavement, which includes mainline travel lanes, shoulders, ramps, and crossroads
- Replacing guardrail
- Replacing cattle guards
- Repairing a bridge deck and replacing a bridge barrier
- Installing pipe liners and fencing
- Replacing pavement markings, signage and lighting
