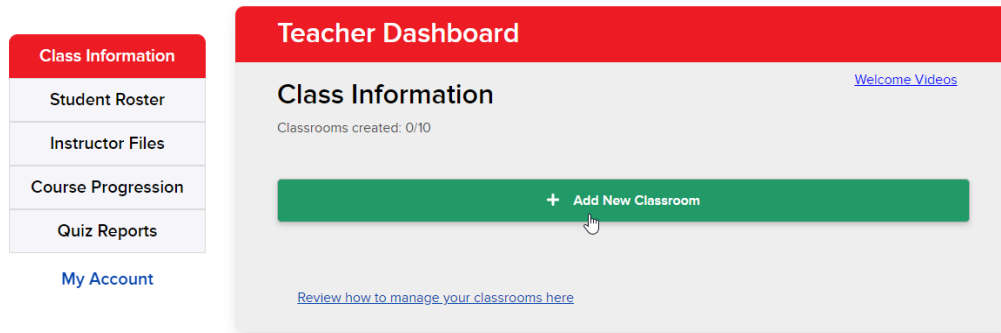
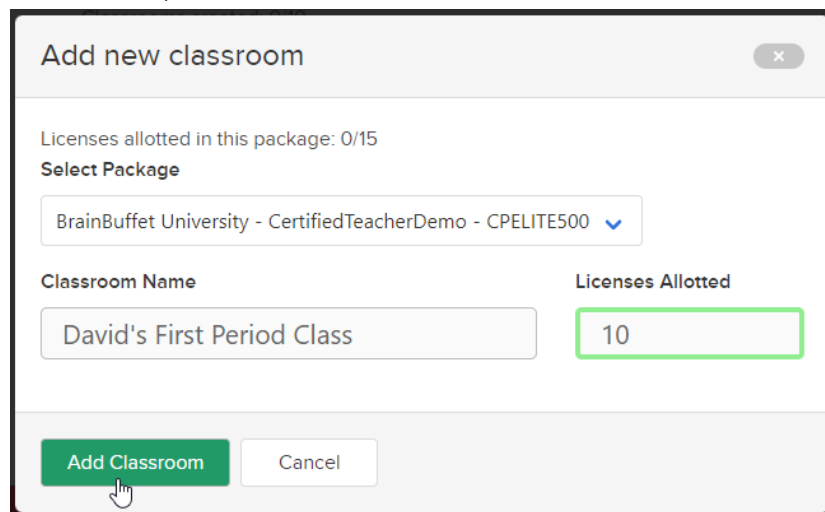


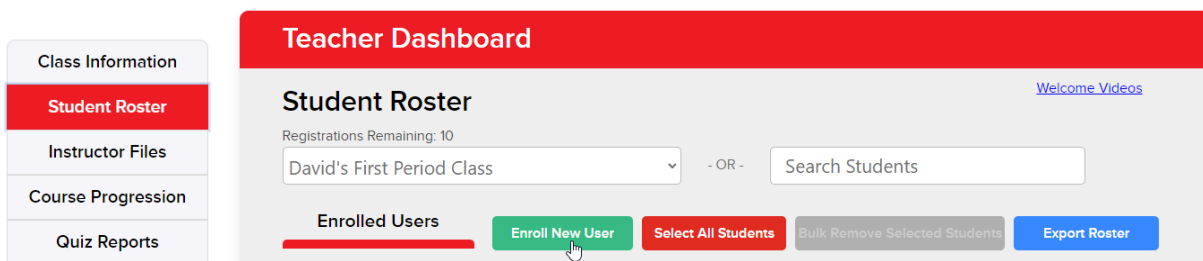
Hey future **BrainBuffet** teachers! Thank you for joining this teacher demonstration. Follow along with David by visiting [www.brainbuffet.com/teacher-trial](http://www.brainbuffet.com/teacher-trial) in Google Chrome. Fill out your **name, email and organization, and create a password**. To follow along, go ahead and click the **“Add New Classroom”** button.



Every teacher in this trial is a part of the same package, **BrainBuffet University - CertifiedTeacherDemo**, which contains access to all of our courses. The teacher and all 15 students they have licenses for can view the curriculum in these courses. Go ahead and type in your first Classroom's name, and **allot 10 licenses to it**. Click the confirmation to refresh.



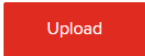
Click the **“Student Roster”** tab on the left, then click the **“Enroll New User”** button. We have a few ways to enroll students into classrooms, which grants the student access to the video courses, but also gives you a way to separate them by classroom for grading purposes. You can either type in the name and email of each student on this page, give the students the classroom link from the Class Information tab we just left, or you can do what we will do now and upload a CSV full of student information, creating an account for each one listed.



When the dialogue box opens, click the **“Upload Users”** button in the top right. This will bring up the sample CSV, which you can download by clicking the **blue link**, as shown in the image on the next page.

This file is a simple CSV spreadsheet template, containing the name and email address of each student you wish to add to the classroom. The sample students in the spreadsheet already exist within our site, so you can go ahead and add them to your classroom to see some examples of what students in your classroom look like, and how you can view their progression and quiz scores. Normally, you'd just replace these sample students with your own.

Once you save the demo CSV, you can press "Choose File" and select the recently downloaded file. Click "Upload" to add these students to your classroom. You can always remove them later to get those licenses back! Once you click upload, you will see the users load in, and then the page will automatically refresh. Now the students will be in your roster.

Click the "Course Progression" tab on the left, then select your class from the first dropdown. The first course - **Adobe After Effects** - should automatically populate in the second dropdown. From the **third dropdown**, select **Project 1 - Introduction**. You'll notice that these students from the demo CSV have course and quiz progress in the **Adobe After Effects** and



**Adobe Photoshop Certification** courses. Some students have even finished the course, and you'll see their certificates available to download right from this page. If you click the toggle shown to the left, you'll see a slightly different view of the course progression, in the form of lesson checkboxes. Using these buttons under

"View", you can also hide other students or generate a specific user report:  

If you open up the "Quiz Reports" section on the left, you'll notice a very similar dropdown selection menu. Go ahead and select your first class, and you'll see some test attempt information for each student.
