**Work completed in the last week :**

This weekly report covers Saturday 11/2/2024-Friday 11/8/2024

In the last week, the Maintenance of Way (MOW) team was hampered by weather and other issues occurring on the rail alignment. The team performed rail defect mitigation in the Southeast corridor with rail grinding by hand. One stock rail was installed at SWT195BSE. A rail plug was installed on a rail break adjacent to the Mariposa shop. There will be minimal work performed Saturday November 9 and Sunday November 10 this week due to a short work window and people power shortage on the weekends.

Rail distribution, replacement, rail grinding, and slow zone mitigation will continue Sunday November 10 in the Southwest and Southeast corridors.
