■ Institutional & Local Organizations

Bass Military Scholars Program:

[Vanderbilt] scholarship cohort of highly talented veterans pursuing graduate and professional degrees aimed to foster military-civilian exchanges and expose the greater student body to military values, character, and mission focus.

Tennessee Veterans Education

Transition Support (VETS): resources for student veterans and the GI Bill.

■ National Organizations

American Corporate Partners: provides national corporate career counseling for returning veterans through one-on-one mentoring, networking, and online career advice.

CareerOneStop Veteran and Military Transition Center: one-stop website for employment, training, and financial help after military service.

Corporate Gray: offers job boards and Military-to-Civilian transition guide leading service members through each step of the transition process, from self-assessment to resume writing to networking to salary negotiation.

Hire Heroes USA: empowers U.S. military members, veterans, and military spouses to succeed in the civilian workforce through personalized employment services and support.

My Next Move for Veterans: resource from the U.S. Department of Labor that offers information about exploring civilian careers.

RecruitMilitary: a military-focused recruiting company offering services that include contingency recruiting, military job fairs, a job board, employer branding, a military base publication, and more.

Return to Work Inc.: provides personalized vocational rehabilitation and employment services to Veterans, their spouses, and Americans with disabilities including wounded warriors.

Student Veterans of America: leads service, research, programs, and advocacy for veterans in higher education and provides career resources provided by corporate, foundation, and nonprofit partners.

U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs:

offers career management and employment assistance resources.

VET Jobs: offers personalized, 1-on-1 job placement support, career exploration, and employment training at no cost to active military and veteran job applicants.

Veterans Jobs Mission: aims to increase national focus on recruiting, retention, and career development for veterans in the private sector.
