Reciprocal Pesticide Licensing Request

In order to obtain a reciprocal Washington State Department of Agriculture (WSDA) pesticide or structural pest inspector license, you must have passed exams AND hold a current license in a state that has comparable licensing and recertification requirements. Comparable requirements include closed book exams and recertification credit totals roughly similar to Washington's.

Instructions

1. Check WSDA's Reciprocal Pesticide Licensing Status Chart at agr.wa.gov to determine if your license qualifies to be reciprocated.
2. If your license qualifies for reciprocity, complete this form to verify that you tested in the state you are requesting reciprocity from.
3. Submit all required forms and fees for the license type you are applying for. See the Reciprocal Pesticide Licenses page at agr.wa.gov for more information.
 - **Do not send in forms and fees if your license does not qualify for reciprocity. Application fees are non-refundable. Contact license@agr.wa.gov with questions.**
