All pesticide products must be registered by WSDA prior to distribution in Washington. Documents and labels submitted by email must be unprotected, searchable PDF files. **DO NOT submit confidential business information (CSFs) by email.**

Cannabis Review: Check this box if you would like your Section 3 or minimum risk 25(b) product reviewed for possible inclusion on the Department's [Cannabis List](#). Before checking this box, review the Criteria to determine if the product may qualify for inclusion on the List. For questions, email pestreg@agr.wa.gov. Only listed products may be used on cannabis.

- Application for Registration of Pesticides:** Use separate application forms for different pesticide registration types (Section 3, Section 25(b), and Spray Adjuvants). Include a copy of the application with your payment.
- Application Fee:** The application fee is \$650 per product for a two year period (\$325 if registering a product during the second year of the cycle). Make checks payable to WSDA in US dollars.
- Agent's Letter of Authorization:** Applications submitted by a third party/agent must include a letter from the registrant allowing the agent to act on their behalf. Letters must be on registrant's letterhead with contact information for both parties.
- Labels:** Submit one copy of the final printed label (including federal supplemental labels and label booklets). Submit as a legible PDF file by email to pestreg@agr.wa.gov. Do not submit Section 2(ee) use recommendations, EPA-stamped master labels, or additional graphics.
- Supplemental Distributor Products:** Submit a copy of the EPA Supplemental Distribution Form 8750-5 "Notice of Supplemental Distribution of a Registered Pesticide Product" with your application. The form must be signed by both parties and receipt date stamped (either pin-punch or electronic date) by EPA. This form may be submitted via email to pestreg@agr.wa.gov.
- Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF):** All pesticides registered in Washington are required to have a complete formulation on file with WSDA, including the active and inert ingredients ([RCW 15.58.060](#)). Submit CSFs using the WSDA CSF portal located at: agr.wa.gov/departments/pesticides-and-fertilizers/pesticides/pesticide-registration/product-registration/csf-portal.
 - **EPA registered products:** Submit the EPA-approved CSF. Include the EPA transfer letter, if applicable. If the product is a 100% repack or a distributor product and the CSF is not on file, the primary registrant must submit their CSF to WSDA.
 - **Spray adjuvants:** Complete and submit the WSDA Spray Adjuvant CSF form (WSDA form [4325](#)) and submit using the CSF portal. If the product is a 100% repack of another company's product OR if it contains components which are proprietary blends, the repack supplier and/or component suppliers must also submit a CSF for their product. The complete formulation is required for registration.
 - **Section 25(b) products:** Complete and submit the WSDA Section 25(b) CSF form (WSDA form [4139](#)). If the CSF refers to another company's product (repacks or proprietary component), have the company submit the CSF for their product using the CSF portal.
- Safety Data Sheet (SDS)** is required for spray adjuvants or Section 25(b) minimum risk pesticides if they are subject to Globally Harmonized System (GHS) requirements.
- EPA'S Environmental Fate and Effects Division Final Risk Assessment and Cover Letter** is required for any Section 3 pesticide labeled for outdoor use if it includes a new active ingredient not previously registered by WSDA.
- Aquatic Toxicity Data** is required for Spray Adjuvants and Section 25(b) Minimum Risk Pesticides labeled for Aquatic use. For further information refer to criteria at: agr.wa.gov/departments/pesticides-and-fertilizers/pesticides/pesticide-registration/product-registration/spray-adjuvant.
- Fertilizer/Pesticide:** Combination products require registration as both a fertilizer and a pesticide. A pesticide application will be considered incomplete unless a complete fertilizer application is submitted to WSDA.
