## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING AND SUBMITTING THE WSDA SPRAY ADJUVANT CSF FORM

Companies must use **WSDA's Spray Adjuvant Confidential Statement of Formula** form AGR 630-4325 for a complete application. The company listed on the application should coordinate with suppliers on proposed labeling claims and ensure they use the required forms.

**IMPORTANT: Labeling statements are based on information provided on the CSF.** Suppliers of components or repacks should review all proposed labeling and claims with the registrant who is submitting an application for an adjuvant.

- **Product Name** is the brand name on the application, or the brand name of a spray adjuvant or component from a supplier.
- **Principal Functioning Agents (PFA)** – Includes all ingredients that are performing a function listed on the adjuvant label. If an individual ingredient or component does not directly perform a function listed on the adjuvant label, the ingredient must be listed as Constituents Ineffective as Spray Adjuvant (CIASA). By rule [refer to WAC 16-228-1400(3)(c)(i)] the top three PFAs in the adjuvant formulation are not considered Confidential Business Information and must appear on the adjuvant label.
- **Constituents Ineffective as Spray Adjuvants** – Includes all other ingredients in the adjuvant formulation.
- **Common Chemical Name and Chemical Abstracts Service (CAS) Number** – Required for all ingredients. Enter the brand name of the primary product or name of the ingredient from the supplier when the applicant does not know the common chemical name(s) or CAS number(s).
- **Name of Supplier** – Required for 100% repacks, when a component is a mixture, or when using multiple suppliers and there are multiple CAS numbers within a chemical class. If one or more components will be obtained from more than one source, enter all alternate sources on the CSF or on a separate attachment.
- **Labeled Function Claim(s)** – The labeled function statement on the CSF and claimed on labels must be consistent with the terms defined by the ASTM International (ASTM) E1519 and/or E609, which is available at [www.astm.org](http://www.astm.org). Functions claimed on a label must be consistent with the functions on the CSF. If two or more functions are claimed, the functions must be listed in descending order (starting with the primary function). WSDA will determine the appropriate term(s) in the absence of an ASTM definition. Acidifier, antifoaming agent, and nonionic surfactant are examples of adjuvant functions.
- **Percentage** – List the nominal percentage for each ingredient in the formulation. Do not list a range of values.
- **Total Percentage of All Ingredients** – Must equal 100%.

### How to Submit (Upload) CSFs in PDF format directly to WSDA

Use WSDA's secure portal at [fortress.wa.gov/agr/pisces/PlantServices/PesticideUpload/FileUpload.aspx](http://fortress.wa.gov/agr/pisces/PlantServices/PesticideUpload/FileUpload.aspx) to upload CSFs supporting an application for a spray adjuvant. Do not use email, as this is not a secure method of sending CSFs. If multiple pages are needed for a complete CSF, then combine all pages into a single PDF file prior to uploading this document. Incomplete or missing information may result in a delay or denial of registration. WSDA will continue to accept CSFs sent via ground mail and fax. If you are a supplier (i.e., 100% repack or component) and are submitting your CSF in support of another company's registration application, use the "Notes" box to record their company name and product name.
