The law library’s online catalog is the best way to discover and locate materials owned by the Alaska State Court Law Library. The catalog includes information on the entire library collection for all locations, including print, electronic, microfiche, and archival collections.

a. Simple Search

Use the Simple Search function for general keyword searching. Simple searching will search the entire record for the keyword(s) you enter.

Click on ‘Show search options’ for additional search criteria.

b. Advanced Search

Advanced searching allows for more detailed search capabilities. Use the drop-down menus to see all available search options.

'Options: Matching: Select Match ALL Keywords to narrow your search using AND (Term1 AND Term2 AND Term3). Select Match ANY Keyword to expand your search using OR (Term1 OR Term2 OR Term3). Select Exact Phrase to limit your search to the terms as entered (no variations of each keyword) and in the order entered. Alternate display: Search collections: If your library has enabled search collections, select whether to search hard-copy and/or electronic resources. Find: If your library is set up to return media separately, enable this option to include media in the search results. If your library is set up for full-text searching, enable this option for full-text searching of linked documents. Year: Enter a single year or range of years to limit your search by publication date. Limit/View search results: Select from the lists provided to limit your search. Once results display, these lists also provide the number of results found (e.g., Format: Book (151), Maps (1), Visual Materials (3), etc.). Select category: If your library offers category searching, select a category and subcategories to limit results accordingly.

Use the location field to find library materials in your location or select “All Alaska State Court Law Libraries” to find materials that are available electronically.
