Safety



- Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 105
 CFVS Decals Issued: 85
- Total Number CFV Safety Boardings: 216
- At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 88
 - Onboard 42 individual vessels.
 - 8 CFVS Terminations this period due to safety violations.
- Observed Compliance Rate: 81%

Search and Rescue



- CG responded to 45 F/V Incidents/Casualties
 - 6 Disabled F/Vs
 - 3 Allisions
 - 1 Fires
 - 2 Vessel Aground/Taking on Water/loss on rocks
 - 38 Lives Saved
- 4 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs
- 0 Deaths 0 Fishing Related / 0 Non-Fishing
