September 2024 – Present



- **Fishing Vessel Boardings – 216**
- **Fishery Violations Issued – 20**
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 91%**

Safety

September 2024 – Present



- **Dockside Safety Exams Conducted: 105**
CFVS Decals Issued: 85
- **Total Number CFV Safety Boardings: 216**
- **At Sea Total Safety Violations Issued: 88**
 - Onboard 42 individual vessels.
 - 8 CFVS Terminations this period due to safety violations.
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 81%**

Search and Rescue

September 2024 – Present



- **CG responded to 45 F/V Incidents/Casualties**
 - 6 Disabled F/Vs
 - 3 Allisions
 - 1 Fires
 - 2 Vessel Aground/Taking on Water/loss on rocks
 - 38 Lives Saved
- **4 MEDEVAC/MEDICOs**
- **0 Deaths – 0 Fishing Related / 0 Non-Fishing**
