

Emergency and Disaster Response Fund Awards October 22 - 23, 2024 39 Awards Totaling \$819,089

\$25,000 to **Asheville City Schools** to provide essential supplies such as clothing, school materials, and hygiene products to students and to hire tutors to mitigate learning loss in Buncombe County.

\$25,000 to **Asheville P.E.A.K. Academy** to provide support for basic needs, learning resources for additional teaching materials, and staff to support the extended school day in Buncombe County.

\$25,000 to **Asheville-Buncombe Community Christian Ministry** to purchase a forklift to help with the increased demand for distribution of essential supplies in the WNC Region.

\$10,000 to **Aura Home Women Vets** to provide emergency financial assistance and support to women veterans in Buncombe, Henderson and Haywood counties.

\$15,000 to **Casting for Hope** to assist women and families faced with a gynecological cancer diagnosis who have been affected by Hurricane Helene in the WNC Region.

\$25,000 to **Child Medical Collaborative** to help address the increased demand for medical evaluations of abused children in Haywood, Jackson, Macon, Swain, and Graham counties.

\$10,000 to **Children's Cancer Partners of the Carolinas** for costs of out-of-area travel, lodging, food and other immediate challenges facing families affected by Hurricane Helene who have children receiving cancer treatment in the WNC Region.

\$25,000 to **Children's Center of Transylvania County** toward essential supplies, such as gas and gift cards, cleaning products, household items or appliances, rent and deposits for people affected by the hurricane in Transylvania County.

\$25,000 to **East Marion Pentecostal Holiness Church** to provide financial assistance and supplies to Latinx people in the WNC Region.

\$16,900 to **FIRST at Blue Ridge** to remove fallen trees on its campus that are making living and walking around campus unsafe in Buncombe County.

\$25,000 to **Goodwill Industries of NW North Carolina** to provide Goodwill gift cards that will help affected families in WNC replace household goods and personal items.

\$25,000 to **Henderson County Public Schools** to provide displaced families with gas cards for transportation to and from school or community bus stops and to provide beds, mattresses, linens, towels, and other household necessities to families transitioning into new living arrangements in Henderson County.

\$25,000 to **HIGHTS** to provide critical mental health services in response to the trauma caused by Hurricane Helene in Haywood, Jackson, Macon, and Swain counties and the Qualla Boundary.

\$10,000 to **Ledford's Chapel - Matt's Ministry** to purchase food for its pantry, which has been affected by supply chain disruptions to MANNA FoodBank and Ingles Markets in Clay County.

\$25,000 to **Madison County Fairgrounds** to purchase a tractor to help with supply distribution in Madison, Buncombe, and Yancey counties.

\$25,000 to **Mars Hill Elementary School** to provide support for temporary shelter for out-of-area utility workers in Madison County.

\$10,000 to **Mimosa Christian Counseling Center** for counseling services to people affected by Hurricane Helene in Burke and McDowell counties.

\$10,000 to **Montmorenci United Methodist Church** to purchase fresh food and produce that cannot be obtained through MANNA in Buncombe, Haywood, and Madison counties.

\$12,500 to **Mountain City Public Montessori** to provide mental health services to their students in Buncombe County.

\$25,000 to **NAMI Western Carolina** to provide mental health services in communities affected by the hurricane in Buncombe, Henderson, Madison, Mitchell, and Yancey counties.

\$25,000 to **Northwestern Housing Enterprises** for clean-up and remediation at an affordable housing complex in Yancey County.

\$25,000 to **Pensacola Volunteer Fire Department** to purchase an all-terrain vehicle to expand its capacity to provide timely and life-saving services, such as medical aid, supply delivery, and emergency evacuations, to isolated areas in Yancey County.

\$24,189 to **Polk County Schools** to offset costs schools incurred while serving as distribution sites of essential supplies in Polk County.

\$25,000 to **Recovery Ventures Corporation** to purchase equipment needed to clean up debris and repair damages to its facility in Rutherford County.

\$25,000 to **Reparations Stakeholder Authority of Asheville** to provide heating assistance and meet the essential needs of people recovering from the hurricane in Buncombe County.

\$25,000 to **Rural Advancement Foundation International-USA** to provide financial assistance to small and mid-scale farmers affected by Hurricane Helene in WNC.

\$20,000 to **Rutherford County Sheriff's Office** to purchase two thermal drones to help narrow search areas for missing people in Rutherford, McDowell, and Burke counties.

\$25,000 to **Share and Care of Bryson City** to provide hot meals to those in need through a mobile unit in Swain County.

\$10,000 to **Society of St. Vincent de Paul St. Mary Mother of God Conference** to provide emergency home structure stabilization and basic living and cleaning supplies in Jackson, Swain, Haywood, and Macon counties.

\$8,000 to **Spencer Baptist Church** to expand its bathrooms with laundry and shower facilities for volunteers helping with hurricane relief efforts and to position it for future emergency shelter response in Rutherford County.

\$25,000 to **St Barnabas Conference, St Vincent DePaul Society** to help those who cannot pay rent or utility costs because of job loss, reduced income or financial losses due to Hurricane Helene in Buncombe and Henderson counties.

\$25,000 to **The Salvation Army of Rutherford County** to provide essential needs to residents of Lake Lure in Rutherford County.

\$25,000 to **The Thirtieth Judicial District Domestic Violence - Sexual Assault Alliance** to support the increased demand for domestic violence and sexual assault services in the aftermath of the hurricane in Haywood, Jackson, Macon, Swain, Graham, Clay and Cherokee counties.

\$25,000 to Transylvania Habitat for Humanity to house displaced families in Transylvania County.

\$25,000 to **Tranzmission** to meet essential needs of, and provide financial assistance to, the transgender and nonbinary community in Buncombe County.

\$12,500 to **Trinity United Methodist Church** to reimburse the Deep Time program, located on the church's campus, for providing drinking water, gasoline, generators, non-potable water for toilet flushing and protective gear needed for clean-up in Buncombe, McDowell, Yancey, Madison, Rutherford, and Mitchell counties.

\$25,000 to **Watchfire Media** to support Wild Abundance in repairing and replacing damaged homes and infrastructure in Buncombe County.

\$25,000 to **Youth Villages** to facilitate mental health support and to provide food, clothing and other materials and services needed to make housing safe and habitable for those who have been permanently displaced in the WNC Region.
