

## Emergency and Disaster Response Fund Awards December 5 – December 11, 2024 10 Awards Totaling \$1,525,000

\$50,000 to Camp Living Water to provide temporary shelter to displaced families in the WNC Region.

**\$25,000** to **Christmount Christian Assembly** to repair its water system that was damaged by the hurricane in Buncombe County.

**\$50,000** to **Community Housing Coalition of Madison County** to repair homes damaged by the hurricane in Madison County.

**\$50,000** to **Crossnore Communities for Children** to repair a bridge destroyed by the hurricane in Avery County.

**\$50,000** to **The Historic Preservation Foundation of North Carolina** to repair historic sites damaged by the hurricane in the WNC Region.

**\$200,000** to **Housing Assistance Corporation** for a recovery and repair program to help homeowners affected by the hurricane in Henderson, Polk, and Transylvania counties.

**\$25,000** to **McDowell Technical Community College Foundation** to support students affected by Hurricane Helene in McDowell County.

**\$25,000** to **Mount Zion Community Development** to provide for essential needs, assist with rent and utility costs, and provide counseling services for clients affected by the storm in Buncombe, Henderson, and Haywood counties.

**\$1,000,000** to **Mountain BizWorks** to provide grants to rural small businesses damaged by the hurricane, prioritizing Avery, Haywood, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Rutherford, and Yancey counties.

**\$50,000** to **New Testament Baptist Church** to repair a parking lot sinkhole that developed after the storm and created hazardous access to its food and supply distribution in McDowell County.
