 - Director approved the requests.

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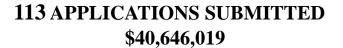

Tidelands Trust Fund FY2022 Proposal Results

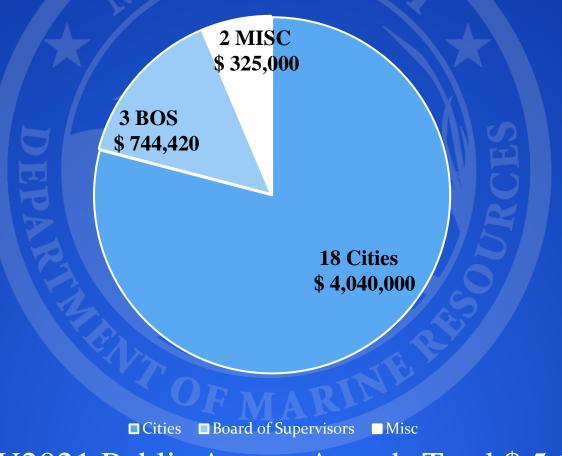

Project Description

- Renourishment of Jackson County Public Beaches
 - Front Beach:
 - 5,325 feet in length and 100 feet in width
 - 7,700 cubic yards of sand
 - East Beach:
 - 5,690 feet in length and 100 feet in width
 - 9,800 cubic yards of sand
 - Pascagoula Beach:
 - 10,496 feet in length and ranging from 125 feet to 150 feet in width
 - 37,500 cubic yards of sand
