OPPOSITIONS AND REPLIES TO OPPOSITIONS TO PETITIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION
OF THE *IP CLOSED CAPTIONING ORDER***

Replies to Oppositions Due: June 18, 2012**

On May 17, 2012, the Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau released a *Public Notice*¹ listing petitions for reconsideration of the Commission's *IP Closed Captioning Order*.² The *Public Notice* was subsequently published in the Federal Register.³

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, the opposition and reply deadlines for these petitions are 15 days and 25 days, respectively, after publication of the *Public Notice* in the Federal Register.⁴ The *Public Notice* was published in the Federal Register on May 23, 2012. Accordingly, oppositions will be due **June 7, 2012**, and replies to oppositions will be due **June 18, 2012**.
