SCDC Frequently Asked Questions

What are the minimum requirements for employment?

All applicants must have a valid driver's license and high school diploma or GED. No prior correctional or law enforcement experience is required. Specific positions have additional education or experience requirements that must be met in order to be considered for the position. Position requirements can be found on the application page for each position at joinSCDC.com. Applicants seeking correctional officer positions must be at least 21 years of age. SCDC has some cadet positions available for persons 18-20 years of age, and cadets convert to correctional officers at age 21. There is no age maximum for any position. If offered employment, applicants must return clean background and fingerprint checks and will undergo a pre-employment physical, which includes a drug test and a tuberculosis test.

Where is SCDC hiring?

SCDC is hiring at our 21 correctional institutions across South Carolina and our many administrative offices located at our headquarters in Columbia, SC.

Are there more than just correctional officer or security positions available?

Yes, SCDC employs a variety of occupations across the state. In addition to officers, we employ nurses, dentists, physicians, psychiatrists, qualified mental health professionals, mental health officers, food service specialists, certified teachers, HVAC techs, electricians, plumbers, caseworkers, chaplains, recreation specialists, and many more professions. Are part-time and full-time positions available?

Yes, SCDC has part-time and full-time positions available for correctional officers and some medical positions.

Do I have to live in South Carolina to apply?

No, you can apply to work at SCDC from another state. SCDC welcomes out-of-state individuals to apply to join our team and relocate to see what South Carolina living is about.

I'm intimidated by the prospect of working in an institution. What advice do you have?

Corrections is a team, and SCDC staff will help you along the way. Every new hire goes through one, three, or four weeks of paid training at the SCDC Training Academy in accordance with applicable guidelines, which includes academic instruction and on-the-job training. Working in corrections is not what is portrayed in the movies or on TV, which is often sensationalized for dramatic effect. Your new hire training prepares you to handle any situation that may arise, and employees continue to participate in mandatory annual training to freshen up on information. If you have any questions, you can always refer to SCDC Policies and Procedures or ask a colleague for clarification or explanation.

Can I bring a cell phone, laptop, or tablet into the prison with me?

SCDC does not allow the entry of personal cell phones, laptops, PDAs, or tablets into the institutions. Additionally, smartwatches, such as Apple watches or Fitbit devices, are not permitted for wear inside the institutions. Even though you are not able to bring in personal electronic devices, you are not cut off from the outside world. There are phones throughout each institution from which you can make and receive calls.

Is there room for career advancement at SCDC?
