

Rustikon Conference

Terms of Service

1. About

These Terms of Service are the legal basis for the organization and execution of Rustikon covering rights and obligations of the Organizer and participants.

Rustikon is an event organized by SoftwareMill sp. z o.o., registered under: District Court for the City of Warsaw, XIII Economic Division, KRS no. 0000957051, address ul. Na Uboczu 8/87, 02-792 Warsaw, hereinafter referred to as SoftwareMill.

Rustikon (hereinafter referred to also as the “Conference”) is an event dedicated for Rust programming enthusiasts and practitioners. The goal of the Conference is to allow participants to meet with experienced experts from the whole world in the field of Rust language programming.

These Terms of Service are available on the webpage of the Conference (rustikon.dev). SoftwareMill reserves the right to introduce changes to this Terms.

2. Place and date

Rustikon 2025 will be taking place in Poland on 26 March 2025. Registration as well as tickets will be available from September 2024 to 25 March 2025.

3. Registration and tickets

Number of participants is limited. Participation requires registration and purchase of a ticket.

Registration shall be done through the [Rustikon website](#) and Stripe platform. As soon as the registration opens it will be linked on the website.

Tickets entitle the participants to participate in the full scope of the Conference apart from the pre-conference workshop which, if organized, will be priced and open to registration separately.

It is possible to change the participant registered under a specific ticket. For such change to take effect, the organizer of the Conference has to be informed at least 2 business days before the start of the Conference.

In the event of the Conference cancellation all the tickets will be refunded.

Purchased tickets will not be refunded except for the aforementioned situation.

4. Attendance

All participants must register first using the Rustikon website and Stripe platform. Tickets can be purchased only through Stripe platform and will not be available for purchase at the entrance. Participants under age of 18 must be attended by an adult guardian or have a written permission of said guardian.

All tickets are personalized and cannot be exchanged between persons except for the situation described in section 3.

5. Speakers

SoftwareMill invites reputable experts from all around the world to share their experience related to the Rust programming language. Invited speakers present lectures and participate in one-on-one meetups with pre-registered participants. Subjects of the lectures as well as their schedule will be made available on the Conferences website rustikon.dev.

SoftwareMill reserves the right to publish information about the speakers to the scope further disclosed in the personal information section of these terms, on the Conference's website as well as on the social media profiles of the Conference and SoftwareMill.

6. The organizer's obligations

SoftwareMill will make every effort to deliver the full experience described on the Conference website.

SoftwareMill creates the Conference Schedule which will be posted on the Conference website. SoftwareMill reserves the right to change the Schedule.

The aforementioned changes cannot be presented as a basis for refund claims.

SoftwareMill reserves the right to cancel the Conference due to unforeseen circumstances. In such an event all tickets will be refunded as stated in section 3.

In an event where invited sponsors and partners decide to host any sort of competitions and/or raffles, SoftwareMill bears no responsibility. Any and all such events must be regulated by separate Terms provided by the organizers of said events.

7. Personal information

SoftwareMill is the controller (Polish: administrator) of all the personal data collected during the registration process, ticket purchase process as well as during the Conference. By registering and/or buying tickets you grant your consent to SoftwareMill to process your data.

The full scope of the processing, data security measures as well as additional information are available in the Privacy Policy (see page 5 of this document) for the Rustikon.

All invited speakers grant consent to SoftwareMill to process their personal data to the scope disclosed in these Terms and in the Privacy Policy of the Rustikon 2025 by accepting the invitation.

All volunteers grant SoftwareMill consent to process their data to an extent specified in these Terms and the Privacy Policy of the Rustikon 2025 by entering into a volunteer agreement with SoftwareMill.

SoftwareMill collects and shares information about the speakers to the following scope.

SoftwareMill may publish information consisting of names and surnames of the speakers, their photos and country of origin as well as short personal statements. Disclosed information may be shared on the Conference's website, social media profiles of the Conference and SoftwareMill (including, but not limited to Facebook and Twitter) and in promotional video material for the Conference. Information about the speakers will also be published in the Conference program and brochures and other promotional materials.

SoftwareMill reserves the right to publish statistical information about the speakers and participants of the Conference such as the total number of the attendees and their countries of origin (presented in a percentage format).

SoftwareMill reserves the right to process and store all volunteers' personal information disclosed in the volunteer agreement for the period of two years after the Conference.

8. Liability for damages and safety during the Conference

SoftwareMill shall not be liable for any personal belongings damaged, stolen or otherwise lost during the Conference.

9. Miscellaneous

SoftwareMill reserves a right to film, photograph and otherwise record the Conference.

Registering is tantamount with transferring proprietary copyrights to photos, films and sound recordings and with consent to commercially distribute them. The aforementioned provision applies when a participant is photographed, filmed or otherwise recorded in the company of the speakers and other invited guests and when the participant willingly agrees to an interview or a photoshoot.

In situations not covered by this Terms provisions of Polish Civil Code shall apply.

10. Refunds

As per the general policy the Conference tickets are not subject to refunds – subject to the exceptions provided for by laws in force.

SoftwareMill shall review all refund claims within 10 work days. The aforementioned time period can be extended up to 30 days when the refund claim is incomplete or additional information is needed otherwise. Full details can be found in the Privacy Policy of Rustikon 2025.
