DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

The UK Human Development Institute offers a Graduate Certificate in Developmental Disabilities. This certificate prepares professionals from a broad range of disciplines to provide services and supports for people with developmental disabilities and their families. The coursework emphasizes the lifespan from an interdisciplinary perspective. Students will conduct a research project, participate in a practicum, and work with individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.

Individuals with developmental disabilities and family members of individuals with developmental disabilities are also encouraged to apply. Applicants do not need to be concurrently enrolled in a UK graduate program.
