

The GNSS enhancement to Tsunami Early Warning Systems (GeTEWS) Oceania 2024 Workshop

IUGG support can play an important role in the development of GeTEWS as an enhancement to the Pacific Tsunami Warning System in accordance with the IUGG 2015 General Assembly Resolution #4. The Pacific Geospatial and Surveying Council (PGSC) is comprised of representatives from the sovereign nations of the Oceania region that includes much of the central and southern Pacific. The GeTEWS Oceania 2024 workshop will be hosted by the PGSC to explore the relevance and benefits of GeTEWS to the multi-national Oceania region. The benefits of a regional integrated GeTEWS infrastructure to regional environmental, climatic, tectonic and space weather risks will also be explored. The participation of the IUGG Commissions and Associations provide important technical and educational resources during these discussions as well as much needed support should GeTEWS implementation be chosen by the PGSC.
