**FINAL BUDGET CEILINGS
PREPARATION OF THE 2022-2025 BUDGET ESTIMATES**

We forward for your information and further attention, the 2022-2025 Final Budget Ceilings for the preparation of the Budget Estimates of Ministries, Departments and Agencies (MDAs), and Metropolitan, Municipal and District Assemblies (MMDAs).

2. The 2022-2025 final Budget Ceilings provide detailed breakdown of the allocations from Tax Revenue, the Annual Budget Funding Amount (ABFA), Retained Internally Generated Funds (IGFs), and Development Partner (DP) Funds (project and programme loans and grants) for 2022 and the medium term (2023-2025).

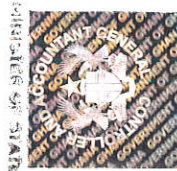

4. MDAs are required to complete data capture by close of day, Friday, 20th November 2021 to enable us review and provide quality assurance of the PBB Estimates and the data captured in the Hyperion.

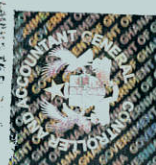
