Semi-Annual Report Summary

Fiscal Year 2024: Quarter 4

The purpose of this semi-annual report is to provide insight into the potential, ongoing, and awarded actions under the ProTech Program. ProTech includes a suite of multiple award indefinite delivery, indefinite quantity contracts covering four domains: Satellite, Fisheries, Oceans, Weather. The data presented in Q2 includes Q1 numbers and the data presented in Q4 includes Q3 numbers. The shared ceiling dollar amount for orders under all ProTech Domains is \$3,000,000,000.000.






Chart 3 provides an overview of the task order awards accomplished to date by socio-economic status.





Chart 4 is an overview of the set-aside determination for task orders currently under solicitation or evaluation.







Chart 6.5 provides an overview of the Oceans Domain task order awards accomplished year to date by socio-economic status.





Chart 8.5 provides an overview of the Weather Domain task order awards accomplished year to date by socio-economic status.






Chart 3 provides an overview of the task order awards accomplished to date by socio-economic status.





Chart 4 is an overview of the set-aside determination for task orders currently under solicitation or evaluation.

Chart 6 provides an overview of the Oceans Domain task order awards accomplished for this quarter by socio-economic status.





Chart 6.5 provides an overview of the Oceans Domain task order awards accomplished year to date by socio-economic status.





Chart 7.5 provides an overview of the Satellite Domain task order awards accomplished year to date by socio-economic status.
