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Transfer Evaluation Process and Policies

To request transfer credits from other colleges or universities to be evaluated toward your degree at Northwest Indian College, follow these simple steps:

1. Request one **official** copy of your academic transcripts from each of your previous college(s). Have the official transcript sent directly to the NWIC Office of Admissions at the address above.

We recommend that you request an unofficial copy for your own records and for advising purposes while you are awaiting your official evaluation results. Many colleges make unofficial transcripts available online at their college website.

- 2. Complete the Transfer Evaluation Request form (on reverse) and return it to the NWIC Office of Admissions. Be sure to indicate only ONE current program of study and sign the bottom of the form.
- 3. Wait for the NWIC Office of Admissions to mail you the results of your Transfer Evaluation Request in the form of a degree worksheet. This usually takes 6-8 weeks, depending upon how long it takes to receive official transcripts and other factors as listed below.
- 4. Make an appointment with your academic advisor to review your degree worksheet (if needed).

Types of credit which can not be accepted for transfer credit:

- ◆ Courses below college-level (99 or below)
- ◆ Courses with a grade below C- (1.7 GPA)
- ◆ Courses from non-regionally accredited institutions
- ◆ Repeated courses (can only be granted credit for each course once)
- ◆ Courses for which a student is currently enrolled (no grade yet on official transcript)
- ◆ Courses with grades of NP, U, I, or other non-credit granting grade
- ◆ Certain vocational or clock-hour courses

Please keep the following in mind while waiting for the results of your transfer evaluation:

◆ Requests for official evaluations are prioritized in the following order:

Highest Priority - Students who have applied to graduate

Second Priority - Students enrolled in the current quarter

Third Priority - Students who have not yet enrolled at Northwest Indian College

(Transfer credits will not be posted to NWIC transcripts until you have registered for classes at NWIC)

- ♦ Every attempt will be made to complete the transfer evaluations within a 6 to 8 week time frame dependent upon timeliness of the receipt of official transcripts and the priorities listed above.
- ♦ The lack of an official evaluation will not prevent you from registering for courses at NWIC. Bring your unofficial transcripts to your advisor to discuss your degree plans while you are waiting for your official evaluation.
