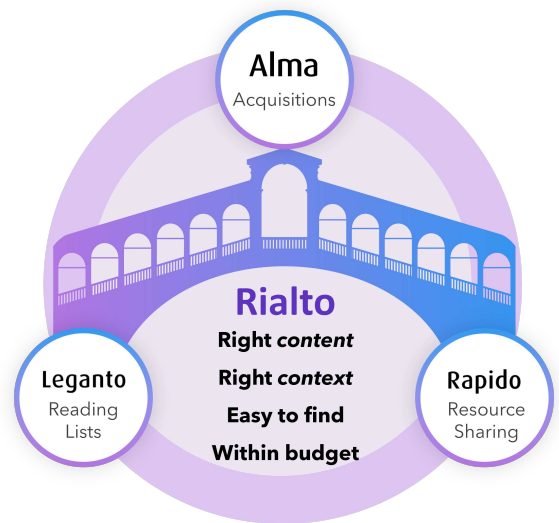

Read on to find out how your peers are taking advantage of Rialto's integrations to simplify workflows, avoid duplicate efforts, and get books into users' hands faster.

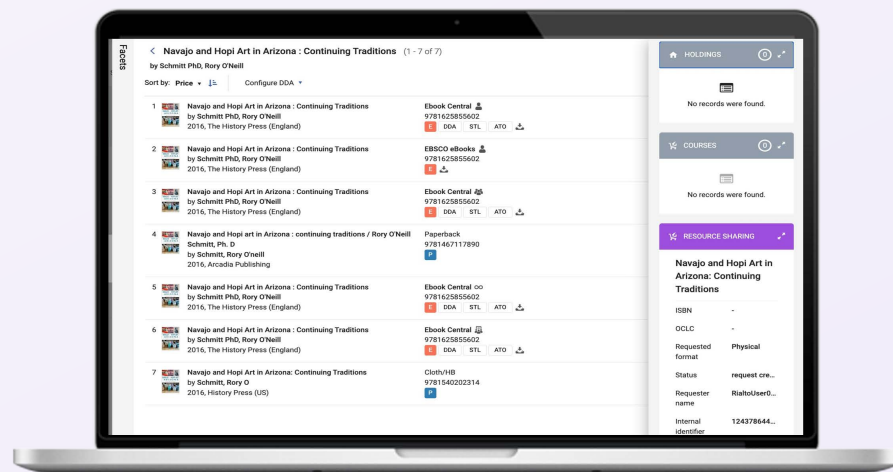

New! Rialto and Rapido Integration

We are pleased to introduce a new integration between Rialto and Rapido to help library staff save time and fulfill patron requests even faster.

Rapido institutions can now search Rialto directly from a borrowing request to seamlessly place orders for books that are highly requested or unavailable from lending partners, maintaining the context of the request without interrupting their workflow.

This year, we have completed five Idea Exchange enhancements, including:

Badge Links: Easily navigate throughout Rialto with new clickable links adjacent to badges. For example, when viewing an offer with an "In Your List", "In Your Cart" or "Purchased in Rialto" badge, users will be able to quickly navigate to that page where the specific offer is included.

Reporting Codes for DDA Additions: Rialto has added reporting codes for both DDA offers added to the pool from a selection plan and when manually adding a title to the DDA pool so that users can enhance internal reporting capabilities.

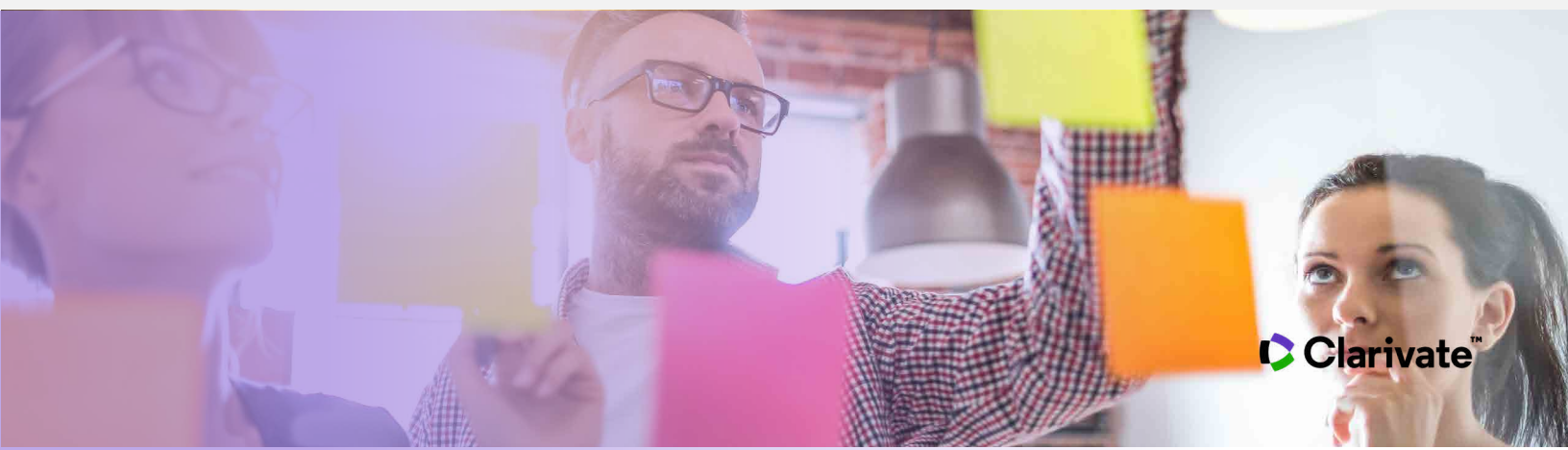
Retain Original Selector on Orders Awaiting Approval: When replacing an offering on the Orders Awaiting Approval page, the original selector's name now remains visible to enhance order tracking for all users. The original selector will be able to locate the title by filtering on "selected by me" in order history.

Introduce Keyword as a Search on Order History: Rialto has added the "Keyword" field as a search criteria in Order History list. Searching by keyword enhances the search in the Order History by finding any values with the keywords in the title/subtitle, author name, publication year, and series title.

In Stock Query Builder Value (North America): A new "In Stock" query builder value is introduced to help users quickly identify items that are more likely to ship the fastest.

Product Enhancements

What's New:

- **Requests and Services Page:** A new page in Rialto with links to frequently used forms and common requests, helping you quickly access the services you need without contacting support. From here, users can request a new platform activation, navigate to the Idea Exchange, request a custom title list, and more.
- **Cart Item Record Matching:** In March we released Cart Item Record Matching, which allows Rialto purchasers to proactively review matched records in the cart to ensure collection accuracy post checkout. A new area within the cart details is expandable and will display whether a new record will be created on checkout for the item or if it matches a record already present in the institution zone, community zone, or network zone. **New in August:** Rialto approvers now have the option in the cart to link offers to different records before checking out, helping them prevent record mismatches prior to purchasing.
- **New "Subject" Field in the Query Builder:** The Query Builder search functionality has been enhanced to allow users to refine searches by normalized subject values, eliminating the need to navigate through specific LCC and DDC trees to find books under broad categories. The new "Subject" field in the Query Builder is comparable to the same field in LibCentral.



Rialto Subject Areas in Analytics

We are in the process of adding Rialto Acquisitions and Rialto Selection Plans as subject areas in Alma Analytics to help users generate reports for Rialto purchases or refine existing reports with greater ease.

The Rialto Selection Plans subject area is now available, under construction. You can use the fields of this subject area to make reports about Rialto Selection Plans and Rules.

Coming soon, Rialto Acquisitions will be added as a subject area in Analytics, which will include relevant dimensions from other subject areas such as purchase request, fund, physical and e inventory, and invoice.
