ASSIGNMENT

Notice of this assignment shall be deemed to be effective as of the date counsel is formally appointed by written court order, or private counsel enters an appearance in open court or in writing.

DISCOVERY

All counsel and parties shall be under a continuing order to provide discovery pursuant to Delinquency Rule 9, applicable criminal rules, and appellate court decisions.

The Department shall provide all discovery to the minor not later than thirty (30) days from the date of the arraignment listed above.

The minor shall provide discovery to the Department not later than thirty-seven (37) days from the date of the arraignment listed above.

PRETRIAL CONFERENCE

A pretrial conference pursuant to Delinquency Rule 19 has been scheduled as noted above. In addition to those matters which may be considered under Rule 19, the court will address the following:

- (a) whether all discovery has been provided and deadlines for any further discovery;
- (b) scheduling of pretrial motions; and
- (c) establishing a final date for trial.

TRIAL

Matters set for trial at the pretrial conference will be set on a "week of" basis. Priority will be given to matters in which the juvenile is detained. If necessary, a final trial call may be set before the assigned judge.
