NOTICE OF RIGHT TO AN ATTORNEY

Notice to Respondent:

The administrator of a public treatment facility approved an *Application for 48-Hour Emergency Commitment*, and you will be held in custody for a period of 48 hours.

The *Application for 48-Hour Emergency Commitment* was submitted by _____ and alleges that you are an intoxicated person who

- threatened, attempted to inflict, or inflicted physical harm on another, or you are likely to inflict physical harm on another; and/or
- is incapacitated by alcohol or drugs.

You have the right to an attorney to represent you in this case. If you cannot afford an attorney, you have the right to a court-appointed attorney at public expense.

During the 48 hours, the administrator may apply for a court order to hold you for five days. If the court approves an application to detain you for up to five days, you will be given a copy of the court order.
