Call to Order/Approve August Minutes	 Meeting called to order at 1:03 p.m. August minutes approved unanimously 		
2. President Capilouto	 President Capilouto attended in person to give a welcome message and campus updates Thanked staff for helping with record enrollment, student success, graduation rates and converting football field to an emergency hospital for COVID-19 patients T. Keys asked what are some of the biggest challenges at the university. President Capilouto said making sure we have civil dialogue when we disagree on things like faith, race, beliefs, identities. Also facing the challenges of natural disasters, like the tornadoes last year in Western Kentucky and the floods in Eastern Kentucky this year. Another challenge is mental health resources. The university is working on a system for students to reach out when they have mental health issues. There will be a help number people can call for these types of issues What are your thoughts on the tuition relief package from President Biden? President Capilouto said his team wants to make sure that students are taken care of and able to afford their education. Access and affordability are important. The LEADS program is in

We have seven research priority areas that help make it easier for departments to collaborate R. Earls: what challenges do you see for healthcare for the next five years? The Commonwealth suffers from so many diseases that hit our community hard. Life expectancy has decreased in the past couple of years so that is a challenge. We have to treat and prevent disease in Kentucky. We are running out of hospital beds so the university will be building more facilities in the coming years P. Noble: she had a co-worker whose car was stolen from parking structure 1 and she also has had personal interactions with people in that parking garage. She would like to know about security around campus. President Capilouto was sorry to hear that; he will talk about security with his leadership team and look into the incident of the stolen car Can you explain more about UK Engage and its potential impact on campus? He has established a position for the Vice President for Land Grant Engagement to help make a better impact on our university and community
