Call to Order/Approve October Minutes	 1:05 p.m. Meeting called to order Minutes approved unanimously 		
2. President's Report	 Investigation will continue regarding the racial incident that happened over the weekend. The student was immediately suspended and is banned from ever re-enrolling at UK and never allowed on campus Recruit, Hire and Retain Initiative: 33 initiatives and the Staff Senate had significant involvement in these initiatives. 48% are complete and implemented, 30% are underway, and around 31% are still in progress UK Invests: pilot started with UK athletes in late October. They will roll out more cohorts in the spring. In Fall 2023, it will be rolled out to all students and employees. This will help build healthy habits around behaviors, not just financial education or financial wellness, but belonging in the community Resources for students regarding bullying, racism, microaggressions, etc., can be found in our Office of Institutional Equity and Equal Opportunity Office 		

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3. Trustee Report	 October Board of Trustee Meeting: It was the Board retreat. This year's theme was research. Learned a lot about Research Priority Areas. They learned a lot about UK Innovate Passed resolution to continue to invest in campus Special meeting called to order on October 27: finalized the purchase of King's Daughters hospital in Ashland Royal Blue Health: owned by UK, but they are employees of Royal Blue Health. More information to follow T. Randolph: are the patients at King's Daughters UK patients? They will be if the purchase goes through G. Redimarker: Crucial distinction for us to know - a lot of our internal assistance programs hinge on patient/provider 340B eligibility. If they are not UK employees, their patient population may not be eligible for some of our assistance programs.
