## 2024 SEASON CAT SCRATCHES

- Kentucky won the 2020 NCAA Volleyball National Championship with a 3-1 win over Texas, becoming the first SEC school to ever win the national title.
- 2024 is Craig Skinner's 20th season as the head coach at Kentucky. He is the second-longest tenured coach in the SEC (Mary Wise).
- Kentucky graduate and 2020 NCAA National Champion, Avery Skinner, was on the 2024 USA Olympic Team for volleyball and won a silver medal.
- UK has won seven-straight SEC Championships.
- Emma Grome and Brooklyn DeLeye returning AVCA All-Americans from 2023. Grome is a 2x All-American.
- Kentucky has qualified for 19-straight NCAA Tournaments
- UK began the season ranked No. 9 in the AVCA Coaches' Poll.
- Transferring into Kentucky is one player in 2024, Delaney Hogan from Xavier
- Kentucky returns to Memorial Coliseum after an \$83 million facelift, the largest investment in women's athletics in Kentucky history.
- Kentucky liberos have won SEC Libero/Defensive Player of the Year in 11 of the last 13 years, including Eleanor Beavin in 2021.
- UK will play three ESPN matches, including vs. Louisville, vs. Texas and at Florida
- Brooklyn DeLeye was named the 2023 SEC Freshman of the Year and 2023 AVCA All-Region Freshman of the Year.
- Emma Grome was named the SEC Player of the Year for the league in 2022, marking the fifth-straight year and fourth-different UK player to win it since 2018.
- Craig Skinner won the 2020-21 AVCA National Coach of the Year award, becoming the second UK head coach to win the award (Kathy DeBoer).

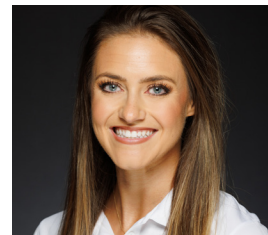

**MEMORIAL COLISEUM FACELIFT**

Kentucky played its entire 2023 home schedule at historic Rupp Arena in 2023 as Memorial Coliseum underwent an \$82 million renovation and restoration. The investment is the largest in Kentucky Athletics history for any female athletics project. The arena will be re-opened to the public on Aug. 30 in UK's home opener vs. NKU with the inclusion of the 2023 SEC Championship banner unveiling.

**RANKING THE RANKED**

Kentucky has been ranked inside of the top-25 of the American Volleyball Coaches' Association Top-25 poll in 116 consecutive weeks. This is a program record for UK that spans seven complete seasons. The Wildcats finished the 2020-21 season ranked No. 1 after winning the NCAA National Championship.

UK is slotted #9 in the AVCA polls to begin the 2024 season, and is currently scheduled to play non-conference matches against: #1 Texas, #2 Nebraska, #5 Stanford, #6 Louisville, #8 Purdue. On the docket for Kentucky is also matches in SEC play against #11 Florida, #15 Tennessee, #19 Arkansas and #25 Georgia.

The six SEC teams ranked are the most since at least 1982 to begin a season for the league.

**JAPAN TRIP**

Kentucky took its quad-annual overseas trip to Japan in April of 2024. The Wildcats played five matches over a six-day stretch with competitions in Japanese cities of Osaka, Kyoto, Shibuya and Asakusa. With the trip overseas, Kentucky was also able to get in the gym in Lexington to prepare for the trip with additional spring practices as all incoming players were folded into the mix for the exhibition matches.

All in all the trip encompassed 11 days.

Dating back to UK's 3-2 win in Gainesville against Florida on November 17, 2019, the Kentucky Volleyball team had either been in sole possession of the SEC lead or tied for the lead in the volleyball standings loss column for **1,042** consecutive days until the five-set loss vs. LSU on Sept. 24, 2022.

### SEC AWARD WINNERS

The Kentucky Volleyball team placed five players on the All-Southeastern Conference postseason team, the most of any team in the SEC and got two major individual awards. Kentucky freshman Brooklyn DeLeye was named the SEC Freshman of the Year and head coach Craig Skinner was named SEC Co-Coach of the Year, as there was a four-way tie for the SEC Coach of the Year voting. On the All-SEC Team, Kentucky had a league-high five players with Eleanor Beavin, DeLeye, Emma Grome, Reagan Rutherford and Azhani Tealer all earning spots on the 18-person team. Molly Tuozzo joined DeLeye on the All-SEC Freshman Team, which is comprised of seven players.

### TEALER MAKES HISTORY

The SEC title for 2023 was not only Kentucky's seventh in a row, but additionally, Azhani Tealer became the first-ever Southeastern Conference student-athlete that is known to have won five SEC Championships with one team in a five-year window while playing in all five years.

## NOTES

### SKINNER IN THE OLYMPICS

Former Wildcat and 2020 NCAA National Champion, Avery Skinner, was on the 2024 Paris Olympic Team for the United States, who took home a silver medal.

In her time at UK, Skinner averaged 3.11 kills per set with 355 total kills, hit .286, 0.67 digs per set and scored 885.5 points for an average of 3.35 per set. She only appeared in 26 total sets her sophomore season (2019) before rededicating herself to the sport for a senior season of 3.81 kills per set and using that as a launching pad for the sustained success.



### SEC DOMINANCE

Since the start of the 2017 SEC season, during UK's seven-year run as champions, the Wildcats in SEC play are 117-9 (.914) in league matches.

### KENTUCKY ON ESPN

The Wildcats will play three games on flagship ESPN this season, beginning on Sept. 18 with the annual Battle of the Bluegrass against Louisville at 7 p.m. ET. The Wildcats will travel to Florida on Sept. 29 for a 1 p.m. ET showdown on ESPN before another 1 p.m. ET match, this time against Texas in Lexington on October 13.

### EMMA GROME SEC'S ELITE

Emma Grome won the SEC's Setter of the Week award six times in 2023, all during weeks of SEC action. That is the most of any setter in the conference. Of the six weeks she won SEC SOW, she was named SEC Player of the Week three of those times.

### EMMA GROME LEADING THE NATION

Emma Grome led the entire NCAA, power five and others, with a 12.10 assists per set ratio. It is the first time in her career she has led the nation in that statistic.

### SEVENTH HEAVEN

Kentucky swept No. 9 Arkansas on Wednesday night, Nov. 22, 3-0 (25-19, 25-14, 26-24) at Barnhill Arena in Fayetteville, Arkansas to claim its seventh-straight Southeastern Conference championship.

### LITTLE MISS 3,000

Emma Grome recorded her 3,000th-career assist, becoming the eighth player all-time at UK to achieve that mark with her first assist vs. Mizzou on Oct. 6. She was honored pre-match on Oct. 8 vs. Ole Miss with a ball presentation from head coach Craig Skinner.

### UNUSUAL START

Kentucky was four games under .500 for the first time since 2004 to start the 2023 campaign. Craig Skinner had never been four games or more under the .500 mark as the head coach of the Kentucky Volleyball program until UK was 3-7 on the year. He took over in 2005.

### KENTUCKY PICKED THIRD IN SEC PRESEASON POLL

The Southeastern Conference announced its 2024 preseason volleyball team and the Kentucky Volleyball team had three members of the team with senior setter Emma Grome, senior libero Eleanor Beavin and sophomore outside hitter Brooklyn DeLeye being voted to the 18-person team as chosen by the SEC head coaches. The SEC coaches also voted on the predicted order of finish in the league, with Kentucky taking the third position in the preseason vote behind favorites Texas who received all but one first-place vote and Florida. The Wildcats have won the last seven SEC titles dating back to the 2017 season and are the only SEC team to have won an NCAA Championship as a member of the league.

Since being tabbed Kentucky's head coach in December 2004, Craig Skinner has rejuvenated the Kentucky volleyball program into national prominence and is the program's all-time winningest head coach. He will enter his 19th season in 2023.

He reached the pinnacle of the sport in April of 2021, winning the 2020 NCAA National Championship at the CHI Health Center in Omaha, Nebraska. In doing so, he became the head coach of the first volleyball team in Southeastern Conference history to win a national championship. He was named the AVCA's National Coach of the Year in 2020-21.

Skinner has directed the Wildcats to 19 consecutive NCAA Tournaments - a feat only nine other schools in the nation have achieved. That run includes eight Sweet Sixteen appearances since 2009, two Elite Eight appearances, the 2020 NCAA Final Four and back-to-back-to-back-to-back-to-back SEC titles in 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020-21 and 2021. Furthermore, the Wildcats have captured 17 or more victories in all 19 seasons under Skinner's direction, including tallying 20 or more wins in 14 of the last 16 seasons.

Playing in the friendly confines of Memorial Coliseum is a tremendous home-court advantage for the Kentucky volleyball team, which plays all of its matches in the historic facility.

The Wildcats have compiled a 495-171 record, good for a .745 winning percentage in their 40th season in the facility. In the last 18 seasons under Coach Skinner, Kentucky is an astounding 237-52 (.856) at home.

It played host to NCAA Regionals in 2011, 2013, 2015 and 2017. Memorial also currently serves as the home court for the UK women's basketball and gymnastics teams. The storied gymnasium also housed some of the greatest moments in UK men's basketball history as its home for 26 seasons from 1950 to 1976.
