STORY LINES

- Tonight's game is the third in a 10-day road trip, and the first of two in the state of Kentucky as Jackson State travels to face nationally-ranked Kentucky.
- Shannon Grant recorded his first double-double in a Jackson State uniform on Saturday against Vanderbilt with season-high 16
 points and 10 rebounds.
- Jackson State will look to replace the top six scorers from a season ago. They will turn to Daeshun Ruffin [Ole Miss] who sat
 out last year and transfers Shannon Grant [Florida A&M] and Juan Reyna III [UTSA] to team with returning players Romelle
 Mansell [Long Beach State] and Jayme Mitchell Jr. [Alabama State] who missed most of last season.
- Jackson State head coach Mo Williams received a contract extension on Friday, Nov. 1 [just three days ahead of the season opener]. He joined Vice President/Athletic Director Ashley Robinson and head football coach T.C. Taylor in getting extensions.
- It's been a nice month for Williams heading into the season. Before his contract extension was announced, the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame announced that the third-year head coach was being inducted into the Hall of Fame next summer. He joins a list that includes Steve Freeman, Mike Justice, Dexter McCluster, Derrick Nix, Steve Rives, Robbie Webb, and Scott Berry.
- Tamarion Hoover and Dorian McMillian combined for 34 points, with Hoover recording a career-high 18 and McMillian a career-high 16 in the loss. The two combined to hit 13-of-23 from the floor and six three-pointers.
- Tonight's game marks the second this season against a team from the SEC for Jackson State as the Tigers fell to Vanderbilt to begin the road trip on Saturday.
- It is also the second time that the Tigers will face a team ranked in the top 10 after facing then-fourth ranked Houston to
 open the season. They will also play at lowa State next weekend, who is currently in the top five on the road in Ames on
 ESPN+.

FRESHMEN SHOW OUT AT WKU

A pair of freshmen, Dorian McMillian and Tamarion Hoover both had career nights against WKU on the road in the Tigers' last game. The No. 2 and No. 4 ranked players in Mississippi as high school seniors, the duo both set career highs when combining for 34 points, with Hoover recording a career-high 18 and McMillian a career-high 16 in the loss. The two combined to hit 13-of-23 from the floor and six three-pointers.

MITCHELL NAMED SWAC IMPACT PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Heading into the contest against WKU on Wednesday, redshirt sophomore Jayme Mitchell Jr. was named the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) Impact Player of the Week after his performances last week.

He currently leads Jackson State in scoring after putting up double digits in three consecutive games, averaging 15.0 points per game, while shooting 41.9 (18-of-43) percent from the floor and 44.4 (12-of-27) percent from beyond the arc. He is shooting 80.0 (12-of-15) percent while averaging 3.8 rebounds per game. Mitchell scored 18 points in a loss to High Point with four three-pointers, before scoring a season-high 26 points in 34 minutes against Xavier with five three-pointers while also finishing perfect from the free throw line (seven). In his last game, Mitchell added 15 points in a loss on the road to Vanderbilt.

NOT FAR FROM HOME

Jackson has several players on the roster from Jackson (Miss.) this year. The roster features Jayme Mitchell Jr. (Forest Hill HS), Keiveon Hunt (Callaway), Avaughn Johnson (Murrah), Daeshun Ruffin (Callaway), and Cowandric Samuel (Callaway). Three of those all went to the same high school in Hunt, Ruffin, and Samuel.

RARE IN THE SWAC

Jackson State has the only McDonald's All-American in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) on its roster this year in Daeshun Ruffin. The transfer has not played yet this season but is the only McDonald's All-American to ever sign with a SWAC school. And wouldn't you know it, he is also coached by a former McDonald's All-American in Mo Williams. Not to mention, they are both from Jackson.

Ruffin originally signed with Ole Miss out of high school, playing two years there before transferring. While at Ole Miss he appeared in 11 games 2022-23, making two start. He averaged 18.3 minutes, 9.5 points, 1.1 rebounds, and 3.2 assists per game while scoring in double figures six times.

WILLIAMS SELECTED FOR MISSISSIPPI SPORTS HALL OF FAME

Head coach Mo Williams has been selected for induction

into the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame next summer. Williams was a star basketball player at Murrah High School in Jackson before playing collegiately at Alabama. He was picked by the Utah Jazz in the second round of the 2003 NBA Draft and played 13 seasons in the NBA. He has been the Jackson State coach since the 2022-23 season. He joins a class that includes Steve Freeman, Mike Justice, Dexter McCluster, Derrick Nix, Steve Rives, Robbie Webb, and Scott Berry.

FIVE IS THE LUCKY NUMBER

Marcus Watson Jr. has hit the number five in two different categories in back-to-back games, both career-highs. The junior point guard recorded five steals in a loss at High Point, and then dished out five assists on the road against Xavier.

MITCHELL AND MANSEL MISSED MOST OF 2023-24

A pair of Tigers look to return to form after getting injured early last season in Jayme Mitchell Jr. and Romelle Mansel. Mitchell played in nine games before getting injured last season, averaging 6.6 points per game. The redshirt has been injured during his collegiate career, suffering injuries in his first year at Alabama State and again at Jackson State.

Meanwhile, Mansel returns after playing just two games last season before an injury. Prior to that, he averaged 8.7 points in two years at Jackson State after transferring from Jackson State.

TIGERS PICKED IN TOP HALF OF THE LEAGUE IN PRESEASON STANDINGS

Jackson State was picked to finish fourth in the preseason poll with 153 total votes and one first-place vote. They followed Grambling State (212), Texas Southern (200), and Southern (160) in the preseason poll.

SHANNON GRANT NAMED FIRST TEAM PRESEASON ALL-SWAC

Jackson State center Shannon Grant was named First Team Preseason All-Conference in the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) released at Media Days by a vote of the league's head coaches and communications professionals.

Grant, a transfer from Florida A&M, averaged 10.4 points and 4.4 rebounds per game last season. He scored in double figures in 18 games including 13 in conference play, including scoring 13 points and grabbing eight rebounds against his current team — Jackson State.

He joins Kintavious Dozier (Grambling State), T.J. Madlock (Alabama State), Tidjiane Dioumassi (Southern), and Chad Moodie (Alabama A&M) on the first team.

TIGERS PICKED UP ON ESPN+ AGAINST PRAIRIE VIEW A&M

The Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC) has announced its ESPN regular season lineup for the 2024-25 season.

Jackson State is one four games listed on the lineup and will be featured against Prairie View A&M inside the Lee E. Williams AAC at 8 p.m. on March 3.

Other games featured in the lineup include Grambling State at Texas Southern (Jan. 6), Alcorn State at Grambling State (Feb. 3), and Texas Southern at Southern (Feb. 17).

CLOSE TO HOME FOR COACHING STAFF

Not only is the roster dotted with players from Jackson or the surrounding area, but so is the coaching staff. Head coach Mo Williams and associate head coach Trey Johnson both starred at Murrah High School before going to Alabama and Jackson State respectively. They each played professionally. The coaching staff also features Tyler Adams from Brandon (Miss.) who went on to play at Georgetown and Kydarrius Williams.

HAVE TO REPLACE A TON

Jackson State looks to replace 90.3 percent of its scoring from last season.

WILLIAMS IN SPECIAL CLASS

Mo Williams is one of 19 head coaches at the NCAA DI level that played in the NBA. He is also one of four who have have won an NBA Championship including Claxton [2003 Spurs]; Madsen [2001 and 2002 Lakers]; Walker [1993 Bulls]; and Williams [2016 Cavs].

THIRD SEASON AT ALABAMA STATE

NBA Champion and Jackson native Mo Williams was named Jackson State University men's basketball coach on March 14, 2022 and returns for his thrid season with the Tigers.

Last season, Williams coached the SWAC Player of the Year in Ken Evans and the SWAC Defensive Player of the Year while earning the sixth seed in the conference tournament. He led the Tigers to non-conference wins over Missouri and Arkansas State in 2023-24. In his first season, Williams defied the odds of a predicted seventh-place finish as he led the Tigers to a tie for third place and a berth in the SWAC Tournament semifinals. The Williams era was sparked by a win over SMU during non-conference play en route to a 12-6 conference record.

SWAC play was highlighted by wins over eventual regular season co-champ Alcorn and eventual tournament champion Texas Southern as JSU won seven of its last eight regular season games prior to the conference tournament.

The Jackson native and former Murrah High School star returned home as head coach of the Tigers after spending the previous two seasons as head coach at Alabama State University. In his final season, the Hornets ranked in the top four in the SWAC in scoring, assists, three-point field goal percentage, free throw percentage, and blocked shots.

Williams entered the coaching ranks at Cal-State Northridge as an assistant coach under his former college coach Mark Gottfried, who Williams played for at Alabama. Cal State Northridge led the Big West Conference in scoring in both seasons, setting school records for three-point field goals made, field goals made, fewest turnovers, and blocked shots.

Williams spent 14 years in the NBA, averaging more than 13 points and nearly five assists per game. Drafted by Utah, Williams would play his rookie season with the Jazz before spending the next four seasons with the Milwaukee Bucks. Williams played three seasons with the Cleveland Cavaliers (2008-11) where he teamed up with LeBron James and helped the Cavs post a league-best 66 wins in 2008-09 and a berth in the NBA Finals. Williams was selected to the NBA All-Star Game in his first season with Cleveland.

After stints with the Los Angeles Clippers (2011-12), Portland Trail Blazers (2013-14), Minnesota Timberwolves (2014-15) and Charlotte Hornets (2015), Williams returned to Cleveland for the 2015-16 campaign as the Cavaliers completed an historic comeback from a three-game-to-one deficit to defeat the Golden State Warriors to win the NBA Championship.

Williams was named Mr. Basketball during his senior year at Murrah High in 2001, and also earned McDonald's All-America and Parade Magazine third-team All-America honors. He went on to play two seasons at Alabama, averaging more than 13 points and four assists per game. Williams was named Sporting News National Freshman of the Year and Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Year in 2002, helping lead

The Tide to the SEC regular season championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. Williams also earned third-team all-conference accolades in 2003 before turning pro after his sophomore year.

Williams has seven sons — Kydarrius, Maurice, Michael, Mason, Maxwell, Asa, and Ezra. A native of Jackson (Miss.), he is the son of Griceldia and Isaiah Williams and has three siblings — Marcia, Michael (a West Point graduate) and Montrell. Williams is married to his wife, Antonia.
