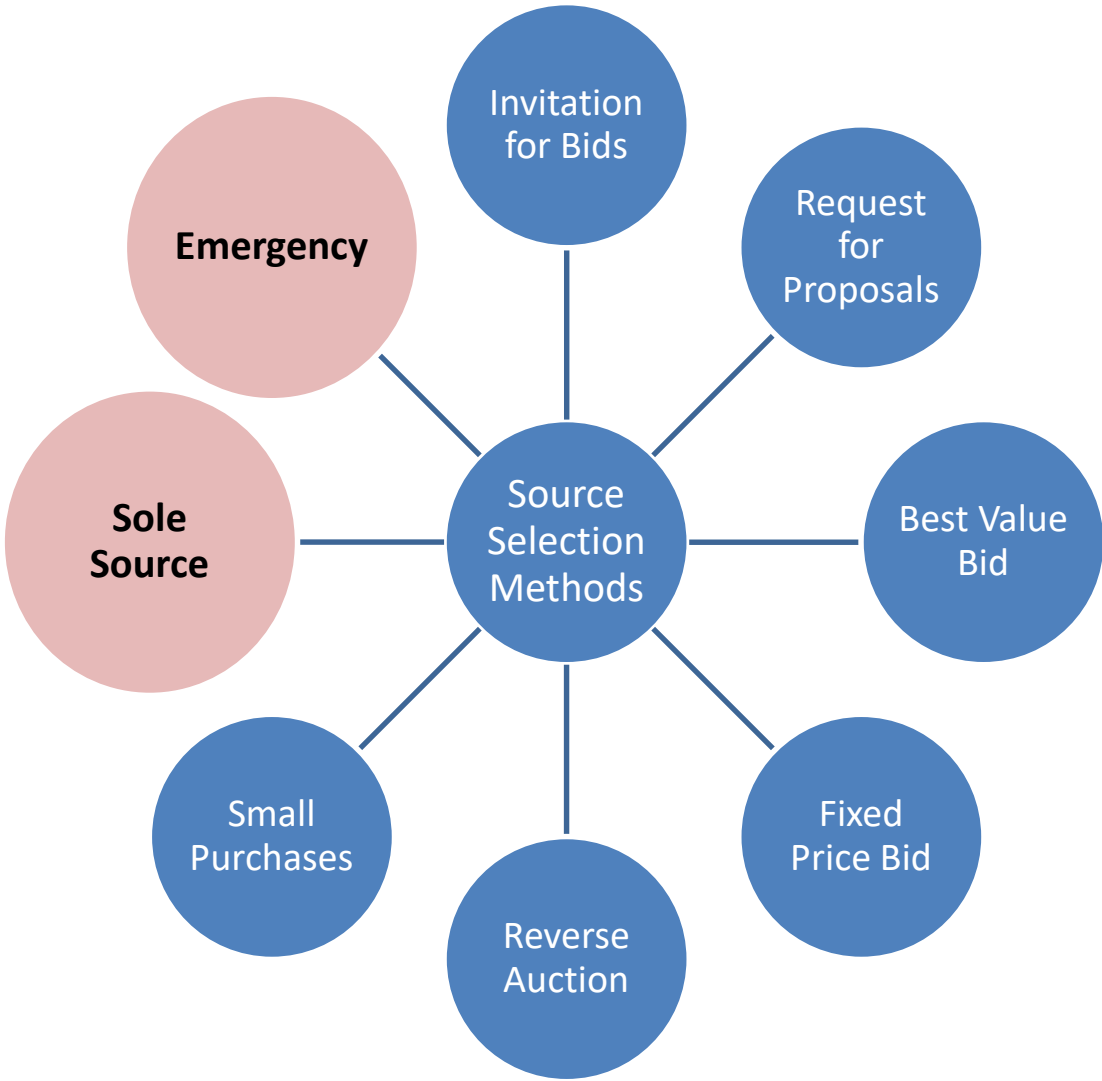


Sole Source & Emergency Procurement Code Changes



Sole Source Procurement

11-35-1560



Requires certification in writing that there is **only one source**



Total potential value of \$50K or more **must** be posted in **SCBO** before sourcing

Sole Source Procurement

11-35-1560

Exception to public notice?

If the appropriate chief procurement officer, after consultation with the head of the purchasing agency, determines in writing that award without such notice is in the best interest of the State.

Sole Source Procurement

Notice must be posted in SCBO at least **five (5) business days before** entering a contract >\$50,000 but <\$250,000

...at least **ten (10) business days before** entering a contract >\$250,000

Notice must contain a statement of right to **protest under Section 11-35-4210(1)**

Protestant must file intent to protest within **5 business days** of the date the notification of intent to award is posted

Sole Source Procurement

11-35-1560

Written Documentation



Thorough, detailed explanation why no other is suitable or acceptable

Total potential value of \$50K
or more **must** be posted in
SCBO as soon as practicable
thereafter



Notice must contain
a statement of right
to **protest**

Emergency Contracts

11-35-1570 & 11-35-4210(1) and (1)(c)



Protestant must file intent to protest within **5 business days** of the date the notification of intent to award is posted
