The WMC filed a CR-101, Preproposal Statement of Inquiry, to establish the use of nitrous oxide in office based surgical settings. The WMC is considering amending [WAC 246-919-601](#) to exempt the use of nitrous oxide in office-based surgical settings under certain circumstances. Additionally, the WMC is considering adding a new subsection to further address the use of nitrous oxide in such settings. The CR-101 was filed on May 17, 2024, as [WSR #24-11-104](#).
