Our GUEST PREACHER



Reverend Dr. Lee P. Washington is

a gifted preacher and teacher. He served the Reid Temple African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church, located in Glenn Dale, Maryland as its biblically based and Holy Spirit-led Senior Pastor for 37 years until his retirement in 2019. His extraordinary vision, unconventional leadership, and prophetic calling manifested daily miracles in the life of the church.

Dr. Washington led Reid Temple from a church membership of 300 worshipers to over 1,500 memberships within three years. Under God's guidance and Dr. Washington's leadership, the Reid Temple AME Church congregation acquired 32 acres of land in suburban Glenn Dale, Maryland. There, it built the spacious 130,000 square foot ultra-modern sanctuary and educational worship complex which houses most of the church's multifaceted services,

programs, and ministries. Reid Temple birthed two additional worship locations - Reid Temple North and Reid Temple DC became Kingdom Fellowship African Methodist Episcopal Church under the pastoral leadership of Reverend Matthew Watley.

As a visionary leader seeking to provide services to a multi-generational congregation and community, Dr. Washington established the Reid Community Development Incorporation, Reid Temple Christian Academy, Reid Temple Restoration Center, Reid Temple Credit Union, Glad Tidings Bookstore, and the Reid Temple Senior Center. Prior to his retirement, Dr. Washington was able to oversee the development of the Woodlands Senior Housing Complex.

Dr. Washington is the author of Identifying Conflict Management Strategies in a Black Church (Vantage Press, 1987) and a contributing author to the African American Devotional Bible (Zondervan, 1997). He has authored the following booklets: From Membership to Discipleship, From Membership to Fellowship: Reid Temple, The Commission System for Corporate Churches, The Reid Temple Stewardship Manual and The Discipleship Development Manual.

Bishop Fugh is married to Alexia Butler Fugh, a registered nurse and Clinical Research Consultant. "The Description, Purpose, and Objective"

MINISTERIAL EFFICIENCY COMMITTEE

This committee an annual-conference level committee appointed by the bishop to review the efficiency and moral conduct of those ministers referred to it.

BUDGET COMMITTEE

There shall be established in each episcopal district of the African Methodist Episcopal Church a central fund, which shall be known as the Episcopal District Budget Fund. The Episcopal District Budget shall be approved by the episcopal district through its annual conferences. The budget will be structured and developed by the Episcopal District Budget Committee, which shall be made up of one (1) clergy, one (1) layperson and one (1) young adult layperson age eighteen to thirty-five (18-35), and two (2) ministers and one (1) layperson, alternately, from each annual conference within the episcopal district. At least one (1) member must be a young adult aged eighteen to thirty-five (18-35). Where there is a person in the episcopal district who possesses accounting or legal expertise, such person shall be considered for election by the respective annual conference.

CONFERENCE TRUSTEES

The Annual Conference shall elect a Board of Trustees, consisting of three (3) or more persons who are at least thirty (30) years of age and have been members of the African Methodist Episcopal Church in good standing for three (3) years immediately preceding such election. 2. Term They shall be elected for a term of one (1) year, or until their successors have been elected, and shall be the Trustees of the Annual Conference Corporation and shall administer all property of the Annual Conference.

POWERS AND DUTIES a. They shall make, execute, and deliver in the name of the Annual Conference, either originally or in substitution or renewal, mortgage notes (containing clause for concession of judgment) and may pledge the property and assets of the Annual Conference Corporation as security against such obligations. b. The Annual Conference Trustees, by two-thirds (2/3) vote of its members, may guarantee mortgage loans of any church within the Annual Conference, for the purpose of securing such funds for use in repairing, remodeling, or erecting of said church. c. The Annual Conference Board of Trustees may take such steps to affect a transfer of property, both real and personal, in accordance with the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of said annual conference, provided that such transfer has been approved by resolution of said annual conference in which the property is located, and of which the presiding bishop is president.

FINANCE COMMITTEE

The bishop shall see that the Finance Committee, elected by the Annual Conference, shall hold all funds of the Annual Conference. The bishop shall have the responsibility to see that the Finance Committee secures the collected funds and provide a detailed breakdown of how the financial contributions will be distributed and administrated to take care of the expenses of the annual conference.

PROPERTY, DEEDS, AND ABSTRACTS (Template Available)

The purpose **Property, Deeds, and Abstract** Committee report is to present a detailed review of the church's property ownership records, ensuring the accuracy and legal standing of all church land titles within the conference jurisdiction, highlighting any potential issues or discrepancies that need to be addressed to maintain proper ownership and management of church assets.

• Property accountability:

It serves as a crucial mechanism to verify that all church properties are correctly documented and legally owned by the AME church within the conference boundaries.

Legal compliance:

The report ensures that all property transactions, transfers, and deeds are legally compliant with local regulations, preventing potential legal disputes over land ownership.

• Financial transparency:

By presenting a comprehensive overview of property holdings, the report contributes to financial transparency within the conference, allowing leaders to make informed decisions regarding church assets.

• Issue identification:

The committee examines property records for potential issues like missing deeds, boundary disputes, liens, or encumbrances, enabling timely resolution of problems.

• Reporting to conference leadership:

The report is presented at the annual conference, providing the conference with a clear picture of the church's property status and allowing them to address any concerns raised by the committee.

ABANDONED PROPERTY (Template Available)

The purpose of an **Abandoned Property** Committee is to inform the annual conference about the status of properties owned by Annual Conference that have been left vacant or abandoned, detailing their condition, potential legal issues, and proposed strategies for managing or selling them to ensure the church's assets are properly utilized and not lost due to neglect.

KEY POINTS ABOUT THE REPORT

• Inventory of abandoned properties:

The committee identifies and lists all properties within the conference jurisdiction that are considered abandoned, providing details like location, ownership status, and current condition.

Financial impact assessment:

The report evaluates the potential financial implications of abandoned properties, including costs associated with maintenance, taxes, and potential legal disputes.

Management plans:

The committee presents proposed plans for managing abandoned properties, which could include repairs, leasing to other organizations, or selling them to generate revenue.

The report may highlight any legal issues surrounding abandoned properties, such as outstanding debts, ownership disputes, or zoning regulations.

• Decision-making support:

The goal is to provide the conference with comprehensive information to make informed decisions about how to address the issue of abandoned properties, including potential actions to take to reclaim their value.



ANNUAL CONFERENCE HOSTING PROCEDURES



It is an awesome privilege and a very challenging opportunity to serve as the Host of an Annual Conference within the 7th Episcopal District. This document from my office will provide all the available information in one volume to aid you in effectively and efficiently facilitating this process. We hope this will assist you in preparing for the conference.

Thank you in advance to the committee and the local congregations for your leadership in hosting the 2025 Annual Conference. Please contact my office if you need clarification on any of these logistical areas.

Accordingly, the host committees and local churches will lead the effort to host the annual conference in collaboration with the presiding elders, pastors, and churches of the annual conference. The highest priority of hosting the annual conference is providing a comfortable environment for all attendees in the setting of all worship services and business sessions of the annual conference.

Thus, the local churches are responsible for providing the basic necessities of hosting a successful annual conference:

1. GUESTS LIST FOR ANNUAL CONFERENCE

- **a.** The Bishop's office will provide you with our guest list and travel itinerary once we receive the information in the office.
 - 1. Guest Preacher for Ordination
 - 2. Guest Preacher for Closing
 - 3. Guest Speakers and other needs
- b. Our guests should be provided the greatest hospitality one can receive.

2. HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS AND TRANSPORTATION

- a. A master list of persons who will be attending the annual conference will be provided to you through Mrs. Benjamin, no later than 60 days before the annual conference.
- b. Make hotel accommodations using the credit card provided by the District Office. The conference will reimburse the Bishop's office for the conference guests stay.
- Arrange courtesy transportation and provide general hospitality for the annual conference guests.
- d. Transportation shuttle services (i.e. airport, hotel, church) are required for official conference guest when notified by the Bishop's office.
- e. All other transportation services provided are at the discretion of the host church.

3. ADMINISTRATIVE AND MEETING SPACE

- a. Meeting space for the Bishop, Clergy and Committees should be prepared and designated upon the Bishop's arrival.
- b. Office for Bishop should be prepared and designated upon Bishop's arrival
- c. Space for Mother Davis should be prepared and designated upon arrival.
- **d.** The Finance Office should be arranged near the sanctuary. The finance committee will need two tables and eight chairs in the room.
- e. Provide a space for each presiding elder to meet privately with their pastors.

4. PARKING AND SECURITY

- a. Make plans to ensure adequate parking for all attendees.
- b. Provide adequate security for everyone's safety.

5. WORSHIP SERVICES

- a. The Host Church or Host Committee should ensure that choir members, musicians, ushers and stewardesses are serving at all worship services.
- b. Provide adequate sound system and microphones
- c. Pre-determined place for the clergy to robe -- at every service
- d. Provide bottled water and juices for the Bishop and program participants at every worship services.
- e. Provide offering table and offering baskets for the worship service offerings.
- f. Ushers are expected to serve at all services outlined in the Conference Schedule.

6. COMPONENT'S NOONDAY WORSHIP SERVICE

a. All Noonday Worship is time sensitive. Please prepare for a service that will not extend beyond one (1) hour in duration.

7. RESERVED SEATING

- As generally accepted and as a common practice, a section be reserved for Mother Davis and her guests.
- b. Because of our respect and appreciation, it has been suggested we have reserved seating for our retired Pastors and Spouses for Roll Call, Opening, Ordination, and Closing
- c. Reserved Seating for Ministers and Members of the Annual Conference during the Business Session and Worship services.
- d. Reserved Seating for spouses and conference guests during all Worship Services

8. ORDINATION SERVICE

- As you know, ordination services are most important to me personally. The local church is to provide the following for the Ordination Service:
 - i. Altar dressings
 - ii. Altar serving
 - iii. Hand washing station
 - iv. Multiple hand towels
 - v. Stewardesses
 - vi. Communion elements
 - vii. Provide hand towels or plastic coverings for the microphones after celebrants have washed their hands.
- b. After the candidates, Board of Examiners, and family of the ordinands have taken communion, please follow the process that is customary for your church on First Sundays.

9. BUSINESS SESSION SETUP

- a. Three tables will be needed during all business sessions one table and one chair for the bishop, one table and one chair for the administrative assistant, and the third table for the secretarial staff with three chairs.
- b. The chief of staff and the secretarial staff need an electrical extension cord and power strip.
- c. Hand microphone for the bishop and a portable stand and microphone for reports.

d. Provide a small table for the Presiding Elders during the business session if available..

10. MARSHALS

a. The assigned conference marshals should be prepared to serve from the time the Bishop's arrives until he leaves on the closing day.

11. WMS MEETING

- a. Arrangements for the WMS meeting should be made in collaboration with the local church and conference president with notification to the Supervisor and SED WMS President before the final plans are made.
- All expenses of the WMS meeting are the total responsibility of the Conference Women's Missionary Society.

12. WORSHIP AND MUSIC

- a. Music is provided by Host Church Choirs and or conference choir whichever is the custom.
- b. Selections of some worship music throughout the annual conferences will be provided.
- c. We are acceptable to altering our music selections only, if the music selections cannot be done in an excellent manner. If you find this to be the case, please contact my office for discussion.
- d. Choir selections are at the discretion of the Choir's leadership. Please advise me in advance for planning purposes.

13. FINANCES

a. Please provide me a projected list of expenditures, 45 days in advance and the disbursement list 4 days before the annual conference begins.

13. CONFERENCE DAILY SCHEDULES

- a. Conference schedules are included and are subject to modest tweaking before they go to press.
- b. Please share it with your staff so they will know the daily itinerary of the conference. This will help you with logistics to assure the conference will run smoothly.
- c. We will do all we can to stay within the boundaries of these schedules.

14. CONFERENCE SOUVENIR JOURNAL

a. Souvenir Journal decisions are completely left to the discretion of the host church and not a part of the conference expenses or the conference revenue.

15. VENDORS

- a. If the conference is held at the church's site, the local church decides whether to have vendors. If it is held at a hotel, it becomes an asset to the annual conference.
- b. This is not a part of the conference expenses or conference revenue.
- c. However, the priority regarding space allocation is the Annual Conference. Please make sure the conference members are comfortable.

16. AV NEEDS

- a. Please, as much as possible, make available the equipment to make video presentation in the meeting.
- b. You will receive a copy of whatever needs to be shown on the screens the day before the conference opens.

17. FOOD SERVICES

- a. Whatever provisions you have made for food is completely acceptable. We have no dietary restriction and are blessed with anything you choose to serve.
- b. Whatever the tradition has been in your conference in terms of who you feed, please follow this tradition.
- c. Please understand, however, the budget of your entertainment should be restricted to what is received within your annual conference sustentation.
- d. All hotel food cost must have final approval through the Bishop's office.

18. KITS/PRINTING

- a. All business information concerning the conference will be provided to the annual conference by the Bishop's office.
- b. Annual Conference documents will be available for the Pastors and the Delegates and will be issued through the Presiding Elders.
- c. Worship Programs will be provided by the Bishop's office and made available for services.

Please understand this is your annual conference. Please feel free to add your own local blessings to the worship service and the entertainment of the conference. Kindly provide my office with any additional contributions to the worship experience, i.e. liturgical dance, mime ministry, etc., so we may properly place it in the worship service.


