## Provide a general description/overview and purpose of the system:

WebEOC is an EPA Internet-based, Commercial Off-The-Shelf (COTS) application custom-designed to make information universally available to authorized EPA Emergency Operations Center (EOC) users everywhere. It manages the collection and dissemination of response information. When used effectively, it is a powerful tool to keep all members of an Emergency Operations Center (EOC) up to date with real-time information. WebEOC can be used during both the planning and response phase of an emergency. It can also be used for day-to-day activities to manage routine, non-emergency related operations. The real-time nature of information in WebEOC allows for timely, informed decisions.
