Review of the jurisdictional set-up of the United Nations common system

Executive Summary

In its resolution 75/245 B, the General Assembly considered the report submitted by the Secretary-General entitled *Initial review of the jurisdictional set-up of the United Nations Common System*, and requested the Secretary-General to “submit a further report with detailed proposals and thorough analysis on practical options, giving priority to measures involving changes to the adjudication of cases involving *International Civil Service Commission matters*, (...) limited to the review of tribunal judgments and issuance of guidance by the Commission, as well as increased exchanges between the tribunals, (...) and to present it for the consideration of the General Assembly no later than the seventy-seventh session”.
