## **Appointment of a CCLM Member from the Southwest Pacific Region**

- At its 138<sup>th</sup> Session (November 2009) the Council noted that the Southwest Pacific region had not nominated a candidate for its seat on the CCLM and, therefore, a Member could not be elected for this region. In accordance with a request made by the Council, the Secretariat sent a circular letter on 8 January 2010 to all Member Nations of the FAO Southwest Pacific region inviting them to submit nominations for this seat. The Council agreed that the nominated candidate could be elected formally at its 139<sup>th</sup> Session, and that he/she could participate in the 90<sup>th</sup> Session of the CCLM.
- On 15 March 2010 the Government of Papua New Guinea submitted the candidature of Mr Lawrence Kuna Kalinoe, which is given in appendix to this document. This candidature was presented by the Co-Chairs of the Southwest Pacific Regional group in an e-mail sent from the Embassy of New Zealand in Rome on 16 April 2010. Mr Lawrence Kuna Kalinoe participated in the 90<sup>th</sup> Session of the CCLM (28-29 April 2010).
