7. The Council noted the mandate received from the 37th Session of the FAO Conference to approve, at its 143rd Session, the updated Global Plan of Action for the Conservation and Sustainable Utilization of Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture, and to endorse and act upon any other recommendations that the Commission on Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture Commission may adopt at its13th Regular Session (July 2011).

Developments in Fora of Importance for the Mandate of FAO 8

- 8. The Council <u>appreciated</u> presentations made on the following subjects:
 - Outcome of the G20 Ministerial Meeting on Food Security (Paris, June 2011);
 - Emergency and Humanitarian Assistance;
 - 9th Session of the United Nations Forum on Forests (UN, New York, January-February 2011);
 - e-Agriculture: Enhancing the Role of Information and Communication Technologies in Rural Development and Food Security;
 - Coherence in Information for Agricultural Research for Development Initiative: making the Outputs of Agricultural Research Truly Accessible;
 - UN Inter-Agency Communication for Development Round Table;
 - Collaboration among the Rome-based Agencies.
- 9. The Council <u>welcomed</u> the positive outcome the G20 Ministerial Meeting on Food Security. It praised FAO's enhanced leadership role as a major partner in this regard and called for follow-up actions in particular through the Committee on World Food Security. In this connection, the launch of the "Agricultural Market Information System" (AMIS), including a "Rapid Response Forum", was noted, with a "Global Food Market Information Team" expected to be set up by September 2011.

Calendar of FAO Governing Bodies and other Main Sessions 2011-2013 9

- 10. The Council noted the Revised Calendar of FAO Governing Bodies and Other Main Sessions for 2011 and the Provisional Calendar for 2012 and 2013, as reproduced in *Appendix C* to this Report. The Calendar for 2012 would be submitted to the 143^{rd} Session of Council for formal approval.
- 11. Greater flexibility was <u>called for</u> in scheduling sessions of the Programme and Finance Committees and their Joint Meetings.

Provisional Agenda for the 143rd Session of the Council (November 2011) 10

- 12. The Council reviewed the draft Provisional Agenda for its 143rd Session, set out in document CL 142/INF/4, and <u>agreed</u> to add a sub-item to Item 11 on the Council Multi-year Programme of Work.
- 13. Interest was expressed in an informal seminar on Rio+20: Greening the Economy with Agriculture prior to the 143rd Session of Council.

Working Methods of the Council 11

14. The Council noted the approval by the 37th Session of Conference of the Multi-year Programme of Work of the Council for 2010-2013 and advised that it be a standing item on the agenda of Council.

Any Other Matters 12

- 15. The Council <u>requested</u> the Independent Chairperson to invite the Director-General Elect to attend the 143rd Session of Council.
- 16. The Council noted that the Conference had directed FAO to take a leading role in supporting women in agriculture and rural development, a matter which should receive continuous attention in Governing Body meetings.
