

Office of Science and Technology Policy on Custom MRIP Data Requests

Custom data requests are defined as requests for data that go beyond the capabilities of the MRIP Query Tool and the public-use datasets available on the downloads page. These requests may come from various entities, including federal or state government agencies, private organizations, the press, and individual members of the public. Whenever possible, data users are directed to utilize the available data, template programs, and data user handbook to conduct their own analyses.

MRIP will make every effort to fulfill data requests within six weeks from the date of the request. In most cases, these data provided will adhere to the Recreational Fishing <u>Survey and Data Standards for Access and Information Management</u>, including measure of precision (7.2.3) and access (7.5.2). In cases where the data requested do not achieve these standards, alternative products or analyses that better meet the requester's needs will be proposed. MRIP may still proceed with fulfilling the request upon agreement, but the requester will be informed in advance, and the provided data will include a disclaimer stating that they do not meet the specified MRIP standard(s).

Requesters will be required to acknowledge electronically that they have received and reviewed specified supporting materials, including disclaimers. Requesters are expected to incorporate the disclaimer and citation into the presentation of the data in any format they utilize.
