## GILMAN-MCCAIN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PRE-CHECK

Before you apply, use this checklist to make sure you have everything you need!

- Check eligibility requirements: Make sure you and your program meet all eligibility criteria.
- Have your DD1173/Military Dependent ID ready:
  Documentation that verifies your sponsor's activeduty status is required to submit with your application.
- Request your unofficial transcript: Unofficial transcripts are acceptable to submit with your application. Recipients will submit official transcripts.
- Gather your abroad program details: To learn more about the details you'll provide, review the PDF version of the application. Don't have finalized program details? Estimated dates and cost are acceptable to submit with the application.
- Prepare to select certifying advisors: All applicants must select one study abroad advisor and one financial aid advisor within their application. Check the <a href="Advisor Directory">Advisor Directory</a> to find advisors registered at your institution.
- Begin drafting your essay responses: Writing your three required essays as early as possible gives you time to share drafts with others to proofread in advance of the deadline.
